NOTICE OF CONSULTATION ON DISPOSAL OR CHANGE OF USE OF COMMON GOOD PROPERTY

Angus Council has received a request to grant a servitude right of access over Kingston Place, Kingsmuir to serve a residential development. As the land is held as part of Forfar Common Good, before taking a decision, the Council requires to consult under Section 104 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

Common Good Property:

Named as **the road at Kingston Place, Kingsmuir**

A condition of the grant of the servitude would be that the developer brings the access track up to adoptable standard and this would be to the benefit of the Council and all the users of the track including the adjoining residents. The road would continue to form part of the Forfar Common Good.
