ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (GLEBE STREET, CAMPBELTOWN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITON OF WAITING) ORDER 2022



On Tuesday the 8th of November 2022, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME

Length of Road within Campbeltown

Side of road to which restriction applies

(U022)Glebe Street, Campbeltown

From its junction with the B842 Big Kiln Street in a northerly Both direction to outside 23 Glebe Street, a distance of 190 metres or thereby.

Exceptions will apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes. The restrictions imposed by this Order which are required because of the likelihood of danger to the public and will be effective when indicated by signs from 0001 hours on the 21st of November 2022 to 2359 hours on the 28th of February 2023.

Alternative routes will be via adjacent streets and will be signed in an appropriate manner.
