

**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(BURNSIDE STREET, CAMPBELTOWN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2023**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the “Argyll and Bute Council (Burnside Street, Campbeltown)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023” and will be effective, when indicated by signs from 0001 hours on the 20th of March 2023 to 2359 hours on the 3rd of April 2023 or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier.

Exemptions

2. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle, which is being used for carrying out the works.
