

**THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(CRINAN HOTEL LOOP ROAD, CRINAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2023**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the "Argyll and Bute Council (Crinan Hotel Loop Road, Crinan)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023" and will be effective, when indicated by signs between 0800 hours and 1700 hours from the 23rd of October 2023 to 26th of April 2024 or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of traffic

3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the length of road as specified in the Schedule to this order.

Exemptions

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle, which is being used for carrying out the works.
