SCHEDULE ROAD OVER WHICH MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE IS TO BE REDETERMINED FROM CARRIAGEWAY TO FOOTWAY Orchard Drive/Queensferry Road 1.All that part of the carriageway on the north-east side of Queensferry Road and the north-west side of Orchard Drive, from a point 2.5 metres or thereby north-west of the extended north-western kerbline of Craigleith Drive, southeastwards and then eastwards for a distance of 47 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 0 metres to 16.5 metres or thereby. 2. All that part of the carriageway on the north-east side of Queensferry Road and the south-east side of Orchard Drive, from a point 35 metres or thereby south-east of the extended south-eastern kerbline of Craigleith Drive, north-westwards, northwards and then north-eastwards for a distance of 22 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 0 metres to 4.6 metres or thereby.
