**DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL**  
**(KING STREET, CASTLE DOUGLAS)**  
**(60 MINUTE LIMITED WAITING AND NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)**  
**AND (COTTON STREET, CASTLE DOUGLAS) (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)**  
**TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2008**

The Dumfries and Galloway Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Dumfries And Galloway Council (King Street, Castle Douglas) (60 Minute Limited Waiting And No Waiting At Any Time) And (Cotton Street, Castle Douglas) (No Waiting At Any Time) Traffic Regulation Order 2008 and shall commence on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2008.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided for in Articles 5 & 6 of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait for more than 60 minutes at any time during the periods from 9.30am – 5.30pm, Monday – Saturday or to return there within a period of 60 minutes on any of those lengths of road specified in Schedule One of this Order and shown on the plan (LSS/CD/TRO/08/01 & LSS/CD/TRO/08/02) attached and signed relative hereto.
4. Save as provided for in Articles 5 & 6 of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any of those lengths of road specified in Schedule Three of this Order and shown on the plan (LSS/CD/TRO/08/01 & LSS/CD/TRO/08/02) attached and signed relative hereto.
12. Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
  - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded or to be unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road, of any sewer or any of the main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) To enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
  - (e) For Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance or other emergency service.
13. Nothing in Articles 3 & 4 of this order shall apply to any disabled persons vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge, as defined by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons (Scotland) Regulations) 1991 so long as that badge is displayed in the relevant position and has been issued by the local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 and the vehicle is not causing an obstruction.
14. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be addition to and not in derogation of any restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made by or under any other enactment.
