

DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY REGIONAL COUNCIL
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ST ANDREW STREET, CASTLE DOUGLAS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1988

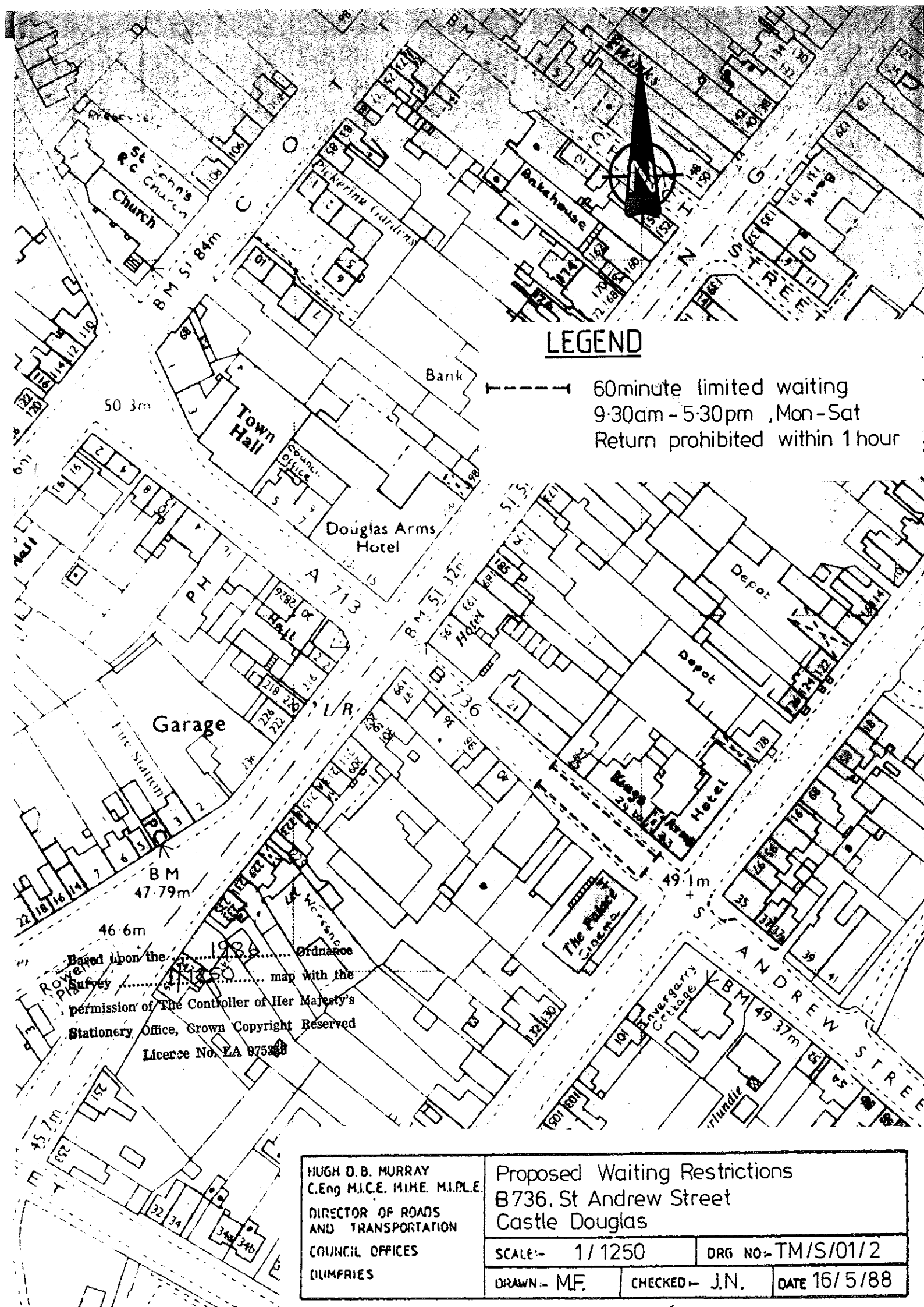
The Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and (2) and Section 2(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council (Waiting Restrictions, St Andrew Street, Castle Douglas) Traffic Regulation Order 1988 and will commence on 28 June 1988.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided for in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.30am and 5.30pm on any day except Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order for a longer period than sixty minutes or to return to park within sixty minutes of the last sixty minute period of parking.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as it may be necessary:
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erection alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by the Local Authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.
6. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made

or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as
aforesaid or by or under any other enactment.
