DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (MONIAIVE) ORDER 2003

The Dumfries and Galloway Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other powers and in accordance with Section 124(1) (d) of that Act and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:-


- This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (Moniaive) (30 miles per hour speed limit) Order 2003 and shall commence on 29 September 2003.
- 2. The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on any road to which this Order applies at a speed exceeding 30mph.
- 4. This Order applies to all roads within the area bounded by the thick black broken line on the Map (Drawing Number NT/2003/04/1) annexed and executed as relative hereto, the terminal points being indicated by speed restriction/derestriction traffic signs as appropriate in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (1994).
- 5. The Map (Drawing Number NT/2003/04/1) annexed and executed as relative hereto shall form part of this Order.
- 6. In so far as any previous speed limit Order affects a road to which this Order applies, it is hereby revoked, but in all other respects it shall remain in force.
