

**DRAFT ORDER**

**THE DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL  
(VARIOUS ROADS, MOFFAT)  
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS)  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Dumfries and Galloway Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and Section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (Various Roads, Moffat) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 and shall commence on [ ] [ ] [ ] .
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order for a continuous period of longer than 20 minutes, or to return to any section of road specified in Schedule hereto to wait within 40 minutes of the last period of waiting.
4. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive, in the lengths of road specified in Schedule Two to this Order.
5. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Three to this Order.
6. Save as provided for in Article 8 of this Order no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the lengths of road specified in Schedule Four to this Order.

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7. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any lengths of the road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
  - (a) To enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
  - (b) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
  - (c) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any lengths of road, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - (d) For Fire Service, Police, Ambulance or any other emergency service use.
  - (e) To enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
8. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait, load or unload in any lengths of the road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
  - a) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
  - b) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any lengths of road, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - c) For Fire Service, Police, Ambulance or any other emergency service use.
9. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons' vehicles which are being driven or used by disabled persons, and which are displaying a disabled persons badge, all as defined in the Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) (Regulations) 2000 as amended or the equivalent legislation for the area where the disabled persons badge was issued and which are not causing an obstruction.
10. The relevant parts of the various Traffic Regulation Orders as detailed in and referred to in Schedule Five to this Order are hereby revoked.
11. Other than as provided for in Article 9 hereof, the restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Roads Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
