TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2008

The Dumfries and Galloway Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and Section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (A701(P) Dumfries Edinburgh Road (Academy Road and Edinburgh Road), U803a Beechgrove, U819a Harthope Place, U844a Beechwood Road, U817a Grange Road, Moffat) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2008 and shall commence on 4 February 2008.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any of those lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order.
- 4. Except for the purposes provided in Articles 6(c), (d) and (e) of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm, Monday to Friday, on the lengths of road specified in Schedule Two to this Order.
- 5. No person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday, on the lengths of road specified in Schedule Three to this Order.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 3 and 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as it may be necessary:
  - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle.
  - b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle,
  - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in subparagraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties,
  - c) for Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance or other emergency service.

- 7. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge, as defined by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons (Scotland) Regulations) 1991 so long as that badge is displayed in the relevant position and has been issued by the Local Authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 and the vehicle is not causing an obstruction.
- The relevant parts of the various Traffic Regulation Orders as detailed in and referred to in Schedule Four to this Order and the various waiting restrictions on the lengths of roads referred to therein are hereby revoked.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any
  restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made or by
  or under any other cnactment.
