The Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Section 133 of and Schedule 14 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 and Section 24(2) and Schedule 6 of the Transport Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 84(c)(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as Dumfries and Galloway Regional Council (Well Street, Moffat, Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 1981 and shall come into effect on 9 November 1981.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- Saye as a provided for in Article 7 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload in any of the lengt of the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Save as provided for in Article 7 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day except Sunday in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order for a longer period of twenty minutes or to return to park within forty minutes of the last twenty minute period of parking.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as it may be necessary:
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
- 7. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in those Articles for so long as it may be necessary:
 - (a) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenancy, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraphic Act 1878;

- (b) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties; or
- (c) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths of road.
- 8. Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons' vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by the Local Authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.
- 9. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or by or under any other enactment.






