

**THE DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL
(B723 FROM C19a NEAR BALGRAY TO C102a NEAR GILLESBIE (PART OF))
(WEIGHT RESTRICTION)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Dumfries and Galloway Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), 2(4) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (B723 from C19a near Balgray to C102a near Gillesbie (Part Of)) (Weight Restriction) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 and shall come into force on 9 April 2020.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any heavy commercial vehicle over the specified tonnes maximum gross weight shown in Schedule hereto on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order and shown marked with a solid black line on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent the driving upon the length of road referred to in that Article of any vehicle which is being used:-
 - a) For access for that vehicle to premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road and accessible from and only from that length of road.
 - b) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in connection with: any building operation or demolition; the removal of any obstruction to traffic; the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the length of road specified in the Schedule; and or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the length of road specified in the Schedule, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 10 of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - c) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose on any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
 - d) For Fire Brigade, Police, ambulance or other emergency service.

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5. Alternative vehicular access is via. U401a, C97a and vice versa.
6. In this Order heavy commercial vehicle has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
7. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

This Order, together with the Schedule annexed hereto are executed on behalf of and as authorised by The Dumfries and Galloway Council by Laura Whitelaw, Solicitor and Proper Officer at Dumfries on the 24 day of February 2020.

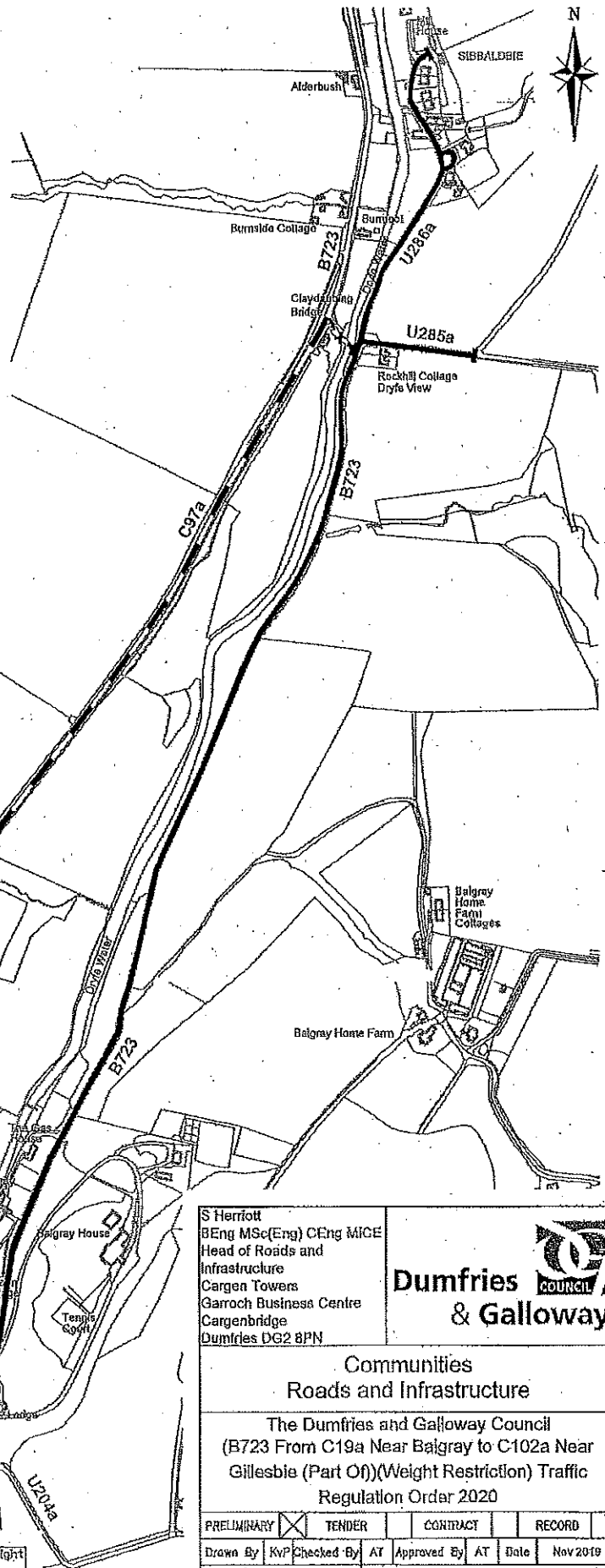
