## DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL (CHARLOTTE STREET, STRANRAER) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1998

The Dumfries and Galloway Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and Section 2(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as the Dumfries and Galloway Council (Charlotte Street, Strangaer) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 1998 and shall commence on 26 August 1998.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Save as provided for in Article 4 of this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait between the hours of 8am 6pm (Monday Saturday inclusive) on any of those lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
  - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - d) To enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
  - e) For Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance or other emergency service.
- 5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge, as defined by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons (Scotland) Regulations) 1991 so long as the badge is displayed in the relevant position and has been in the latest and the latest and the latest and the latest articles.

6.
