

# DRAFT ORDER

**THE DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL  
(A714 WIGTOWN ROAD AND U323w CAIRNSMORE AVENUE,  
NEWTON STEWART)  
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS)  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The Dumfries and Galloway Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and Section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (A714 Wigtown Road and U323w Cairnsmore Avenue, Newton Stewart) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2022 and shall commence on [ ] [ ] 2022.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided for in Articles 4 and 5 this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order and shown marked with a solid black line on the Map annexed and executed as relative hereto at any time.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
  - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle,
  - b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle,
  - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
  - d) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties, and
  - e) for Fire Service, Police, Ambulance or other emergency service.
5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons' vehicles which are being driven or used by disabled persons, and which are displaying a disabled persons badge, all as defined in Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) (Regulations) 2000 and which are not causing an obstruction.

- 6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made or by or under any other enactment.

**NO WAITING AT ANY TIME**

<b>Road</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
<b>1) A714 Wigtown Road</b>	a) North-east side. From a point in line with the north-west channel of Cairnsmore Avenue north-westwards for a distance of 10 metres, or thereby.  b) North-east side. From a point in line with the south-east channel of Cairnsmore Avenue south-eastwards for a distance of some 10 metres, or thereby.
<b>2) U323w Cairnsmore Avenue</b>	a) North-west side. From a point in line with the north-east channel of Wigtown Road north-eastwards to a point in line with the north-west gable of 1 Cairnsmore Avenue, a distance of some 46 metres, or thereby.  b) South-east side. From a point in line with the north-east channel of Wigtown Road north-eastwards for a distance of some 10 metres, or thereby.
