


THE DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY COUNCIL
(U552s URR ROAD, DALBEATTIE)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

The Dumfries and Galloway Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) and Section 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Section 124(1)(c) of that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The Dumfries and Galloway Council (U552s Urr Road, Dalbeattie) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2024 and shall commence on 27 May 2024.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Save as provided for in Articles 4 and 5 this Order, no person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Officer in uniform, shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of road specified in Schedule One to this Order and shown marked with a solid black line on the Map annexed and executed as relative hereto at any time.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as it may be necessary:
 - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle,
 - b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle,
 - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - d) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties, and
 - e) for Fire Service, Police, Ambulance or other emergency service.
5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any disabled persons' vehicles which are being driven or used by disabled persons, and which are displaying a disabled persons badge, all as defined in Disabled Persons (Badge for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) (Regulations) 2000 and which are not causing an obstruction.

6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made or by or under any other enactment.



TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024**

The Dumfries and Galloway Council as Traffic Authority consider it expedient to make The Dumfries and Galloway Council (U552s Urr Road, Dalbeattie) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2024 for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs; and facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

The Waste and Environment Department of Dumfries and Galloway Council have reported issues with parked vehicles obstructing visibility and restricting vehicular movement for vehicles along specified lengths of the U552s Urr Road. The proposed restrictions will keep the carriageway free from parked vehicles, maintain access for all road users and keep visibility splays at junctions clear.

Restricting parking at these locations will impact on the safe and efficient use of these carriageways and junctions by vehicular traffic and remove congestion at inappropriate locations, thereby improving the amenity of the area through which the road runs.

The proposed restrictions will have the effect of maintaining access and improving vehicle flow and visibility on the road and other local roads thereby facilitating passage.
