

**EAST AYRSHIRE COUNCIL  
(ROUTE A71, GALSTON)(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201\_**

East Ayrshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order.

***Citation and commencement***

1. This Order may be cited as "East Ayrshire Council (Route A71, Galston)(40mph Speed Limit) Order 201\_", and shall come into operation on

***Interpretation***

2. In this Order unless the context otherwise requires:
  - a) "the 1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - b) A reference in this Order to any enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
  - c) A reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

***Provisions***

3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
