(A70 at Ochiltree, Cumnock, Lugar and Muirkirk)  
(Extension of 30 mph Speed Limits) Order 1996

The Strathclyde Regional Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The Strathclyde Regional Council (A70 at Ochiltree, Cumnock, Lugar and Muirkirk) (Extension to 30mph Speed Limits) Order 1996" and shall come into operation on the Sixteenth day of February, Nineteen Hundred and Ninety Six.
2. The lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81(1) of the Act, which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on a restricted road.

SCHEDULE

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Lengths of Roads in the Region of Strathclyde

A70, at Ochiltree

1. That length of the A70 from a point 90 metres south of the south kerb of Main Street, Ochiltree southwards for a distance of 100 metres.
2. That length of the A70 from a point 36 metres south of the south side of Burnock Bridge, Ochiltree southeastwards for a distance of 54 metres.

A70, at Cumnock

1. That length of the A70 from a point 27 metres east of the east wall of the Avenue, Cumnock westwards for a distance of 35 metres.

A70, at Lugar

1. That length of the A70 from a point 9 metres east of the east edge of carriageway of Thornwood Drive, Lugar southwestwards for a distance of 44 metres.
2. That length of the A70 from a point 18 metres east of the east edge of carriageway of the farm access leading to weir, Lugar eastwards for a distance of 55 metres.

A70, at Muirkirk

1. That length of the A70 from a point 27 metres east of the east edge of carriageway of the access to Kerlstone (Mansefield House), Muirkirk eastwards for a distance of 59 metres.
