THE BURGH OF KILMARNOCK (40 m.p.h. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1975

The Provost, Magistrates and Councillors of the Burgh of Kilmarnock, in exercise of their powers under Section 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and after consultation with the Chief Constable for the County of Ayr and with the consent of the Secretary of State hereby MAKE the following ORDER:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Burgh of Kilmarnock (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order, 1975, and shall come into operation on twenty first day of April Nineteen hundred and seventy five.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1899 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Made by the Provost, Magistrates and Councillors of the Burgh of Kilmarnock this Ninth day of April Nineteen hundred and seventy five.

SCHEDULE

Queen's Drive (A 71) - From the South side of Victoria Bridge to the junction of Hurlford Interchange a distance of 1,160 yards.
