(ROUTE B778, KINLOCH AVENUE TO LAINSHAW STREET)
(RESTRICTED ROADS AND AMENDMENT) ORDER 2006

East Ayrshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 82 (2), 83(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as "The East Ayrshire Council (Route B778, Kinloch Avenue to Lainshaw Street) (Restricted Roads and Amendment) Order 2006" and shall come into operation on the 14th day of April 2006.
2.
 - a) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them –

"The Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
 - b) A reference in this Order or any enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended by the subsequent enactment.
 - c) A reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. The lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purposes of Section 81(1) of the Act which imposes a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on a restricted road.
4. The Order specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall have effect subject to the amendments specified in that schedule.

SCHEDULE 1

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length of Road in Local Authority Area of East Ayrshire

That length of the B778 in Stewarton which extends from a point 270 metres west of the extended northwest edge of the carriageway of Kinloch Avenue, Stewarton eastwards and southeastwards via Dalry Road and Standalane to its junction with A735 Lainshaw Street, Stewarton, a distance of 945 metres or thereby.
