

**East Ayrshire Council**  
**(Various Roads, Kilmarnock) (Events) (Temporary Road Closures, Prohibition**  
**of Waiting and Loading and Banned Turns)**  
**Experimental Order 2023**

East Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to said Act and having complied with the statutory requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, as amended, hereby make the following Order:-

**PART I**

**GENERAL**

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the "East Ayrshire Council (Various Roads, Kilmarnock) (Events) (Temporary Road Closures, Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Banned Turns) Experimental Order 2023" and shall come into operation on 23/10/23 for a period not exceeding 6 months.

*Interpretation*

- 2.a) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them—

“the 1984 Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“Council” means East Ayrshire Council

“road” has the same meaning as in Section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;

“Schedule” means the Schedules annexed as relative hereto;

“vehicle” unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power.

“universal service provider” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

“universal postal service” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

“bus” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers (exclusive of the driver);

“event” means any public event held within the grounds of the Dean Castle Country Park;

“event area” means the roads affected by traffic management arrangements as detailed, where relevant, within the schedules;

“site” means the Dean Castle Country Park.

- b) A reference in this Order to any enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- c) A reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

## **PART II**

### **ROAD CLOSURE**

#### *Temporary Road Closure*

- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order when temporary traffic signs/cones in accordance with diagram 636 or 640.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, as amended have been placed on any part or side or length of the road by a police officer in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 will apply so as to prevent any vehicle from being driven in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 for as long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties in connection with police, fire & rescue, ambulance and coastguard purposes.
- 5. Nothing in Article 3 will apply so as to prevent any vehicle from being driven in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 for as long as may be necessary to enable any vehicle being used in connection with the event to gain access to and egress from the site or to work within the site.
- 6. Nothing in Article 3 will apply so as to prevent any vehicle from being driven in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 for as long as may be necessary

to enable any vehicle to gain access to and egress from any property or premises within the event area.

### **PART III**

#### **WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS**

##### *Temporary Waiting and Loading*

7. Save as provided in Articles 8 and 9, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load at any time in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order when temporary traffic signs/cones in accordance with diagram 636 or 640.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, as amended have been placed on any part or side or lengths of roads by a police officer in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council.
8. Nothing in Article 7 shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of roads referred to in that Article—
  - i. for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - ii. for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of roads so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of roads, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any electronic communications apparatus;
  - iii. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used to access premises, or in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire & rescue and ambulance purposes;
  - iv. if the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond their control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property;

- v. if the vehicle bearing the livery of a provider of a universal postal service which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be collected or delivered to or from adjacent premises or posting boxes;
  - vi. for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is standing at the kerb and is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
  - vii. to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with wedding or funeral operations.
  - viii. if the vehicle is in the service of or employed by East Ayrshire Council, or an appointed contractor and is waiting in any of the lengths of roads so referred for a provision of service, or whilst being used in connection with the implementation and maintenance of the traffic management signs pertaining to this Order;
  - ix. for the purposes of event-organised shuttle bus services.
9. Notwithstanding anything in Article 8, the driver of a vehicle waiting shall move the said vehicle on the instruction of a police officer in uniform or parking attendant in uniform whenever such moving may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing an obstruction or danger to others.

#### **PART IV**

#### **BANNED MOVEMENT**

##### *Banned Right Turn*

10. No person shall cause entry into, passage within, or permit to be driven by any vehicle in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 into the length of road specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 in the direction specified in that Schedule when temporary traffic signs/cones in accordance with diagram 636 or 640.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, as amended, have been placed on any part or side or lengths of said roads by a police officer in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council.

##### *Banned Left Turn*

11. No person shall cause entry into, passage within, or permit to be driven by any vehicle in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 into the length of road specified in Column 2 of Schedule 4 in the direction specified in that Schedule when temporary traffic signs/cones in accordance with diagram 636 or 640.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016, as amended, have been placed on any part or side or lengths of said roads by a police officer in uniform or a parking attendant in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council.

*Power to modify or suspend the Order*

12. The Head of Roads (Ayrshire Roads Alliance) may after such consultation and notice as is required by law, modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it in accordance with Section 10(2) of the 1984 Act if it appears to him or her essential—
- (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
  - (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
  - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.

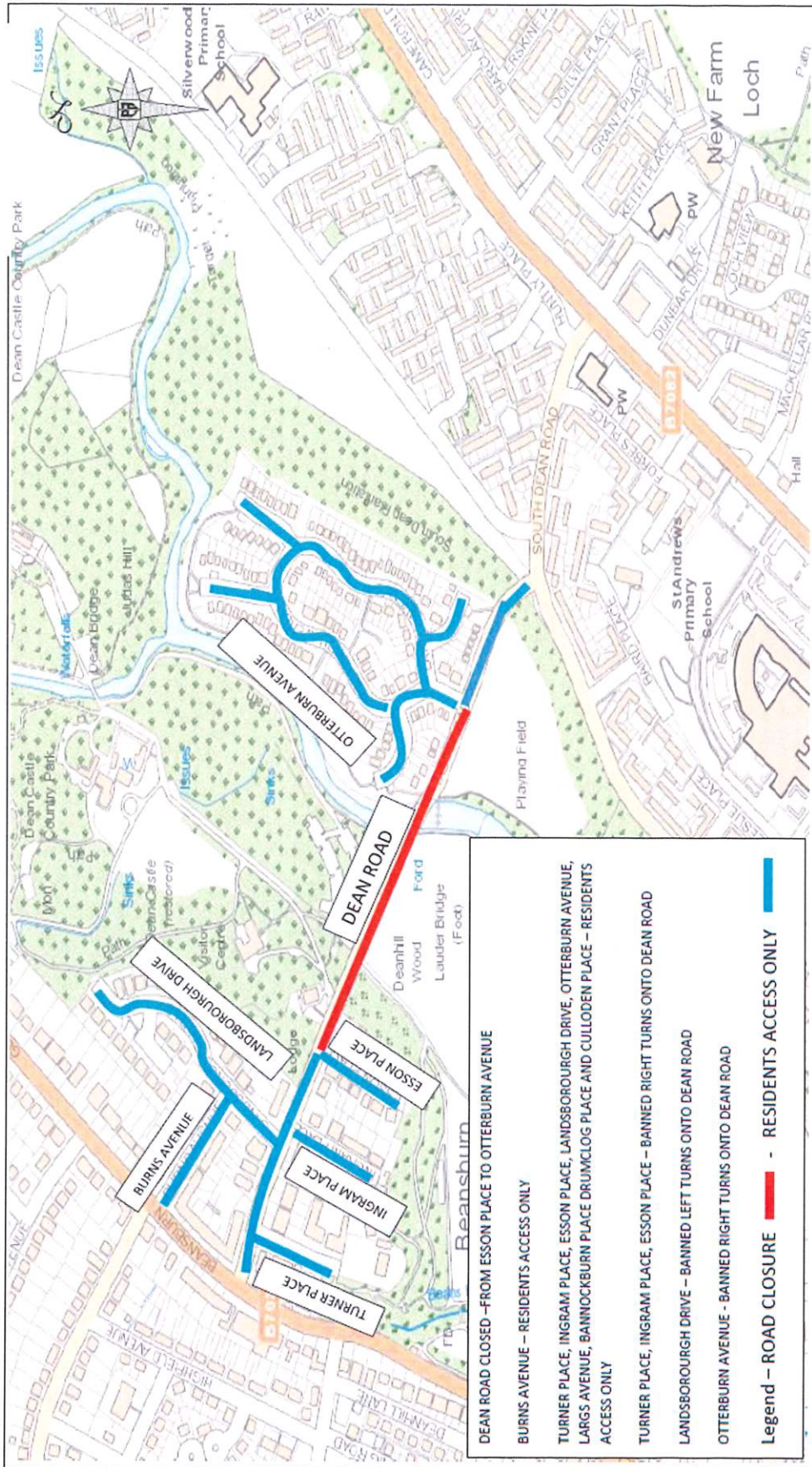

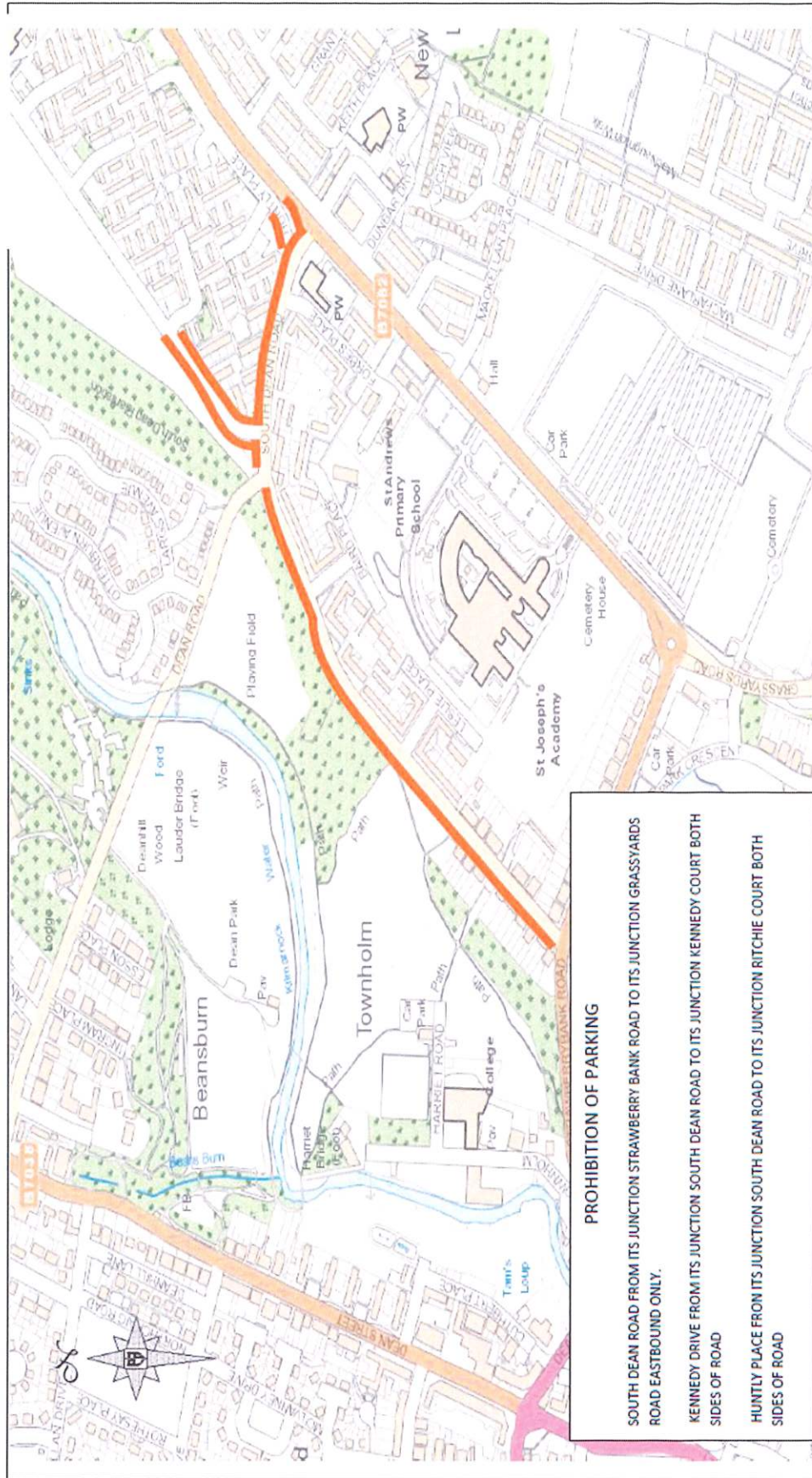
