

**East Ayrshire Council**

**(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles)**  
**Experimental Order 2024**

East Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to said Act and having complied with the statutory requirements of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, as amended, hereby make the following Order :-

**PART I**

**GENERAL**

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the "East Ayrshire Council (Bonnyton Road, Kilmarnock) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Experimental Order 2024 and shall come into operation on 01/04/2024 for a period not exceeding 18 months.

*Interpretation*

2. a) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them—

"the 1984 Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Council" means East Ayrshire Council;

"motor vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires means a mechanically propelled vehicle including mopeds intended or adapted for use on roads;

"pedal cycle" means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle, not being mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle that is not treated as a motor vehicle;

"moped" means a motor cycle which has a kerbside weight not exceeding 250 kg, and if propelled by an internal combustion engine, has an engine with a cylinder capacity which does not exceed 50 cc, and is designed to have a maximum speed not exceeding 30 mph;

"road" has the same meaning as in Section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;

"Schedule" means the Schedule annexed and signed as relative hereto;

- b) A reference in this Order to any enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment or order.

- c) A reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

**PART II**

**PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

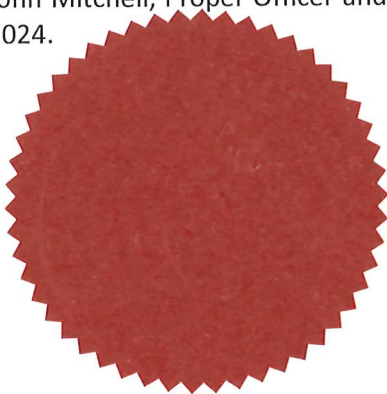
*Prohibition of motor vehicles*

- 3 Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven so as to enter, wait in, or pass through the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall prevent a person from causing or permitting a motor vehicle or moped to be so driven to enable the motor vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire & rescue and ambulance purposes;
5. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to a pedal cycle.

*Power to modify or suspend the Order*

6. The Head of Roads (Ayrshire Roads Alliance) may after such consultation and notice as are required by law, modify or suspend the operation of the Order or any provision of it in accordance with Section 10(2) of the 1984 Act if it appears to him or her essential—
- (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic,
  - (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
  - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
