EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL (PINKIE ROAD, MUSSELBURGH)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2012

EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the "East Lothian Council (Pinkie Road, Musselburgh) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2012" and shall come into operation at 00.01 hours on the nineteenth day of March two thousand and twelve up to and including 23.59 hours on the Twentieth day of April two thousand and twelve to facilitate the resurfacing / reconstruction of Pinkie Road from Grove Street to Newbigging.
2. No person shall drive through, wait in, load or unload a vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven through or to wait or be loaded or unloaded on that section of Pinkie Road from Grove Street to Newbigging during the course of the works.
3. The diversion route for general westbound traffic shall be by way of B6454 Pinkie Road, Ashgrove, A.199 Linkfield Road, A199 High Street, C.90 Newbigging and B6454 Pinkie Road and the reverse for eastbound traffic
4. The contractors construction vehicles are exempted from these restrictions
5. Pedestrian access will not be affected.
6. Emergency access will be affected however the Police , Fire and Ambulance services have been contacted and alternative arrangements are in place
7. Bus services will be affected however the affected companies have been notified and alternative arrangements will be in place
