(40MPH SPEED LIMIT AND RESTRICTED ROADS) (A199
DOLPHINGSTONE COTTAGES, TRANENT)
(VARIATION) ORDER 2017**

TO 221/17

EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (which Act so amended is hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the “East Lothian Council (Various Roads, East Lothian) (40mph Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) (A199, Dolphingstone Cottages) (Variation) Order 2017”
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, The East Lothian Council (Various Roads, East Lothian) (40mph Speed Limit and Restricted Roads) Order 2004 (hereinafter referred to as “the 2004 Order”) shall have effect subject to the following amendment: -

In Schedule 1 “lengths of road in East Lothian to be subject to 40mph restriction” of the 2004 Order after part 4 there shall be added “part 6. A199, from a point 590 metres or thereby east of the south kerblines of route B1361 Wallyford Toll, eastwards for a distance of 500 metres or thereby”
