EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN ABERLADY, DREM, GULLANE, LONGNIDDY AND NORTH BERWICK) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2018

TO 101/18/GF

EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 16A(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the "East Lothian Council (Various Roads In Aberlady, Drem, Gullane, Longniddry and North Berwick) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2018" and shall come into operation at 0700 hrs on the 1st day of July two thousand and eighteen and continue in force up to 1600 hrs on the 30th day of July two thousand and eighteen.

2. Interpretation

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable of The Police Service of Scotland;

"road" includes part of a road and Right of Way;

"Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;

"street trader's licence" means a licence of that name issued under the powers contained in the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

"taxi" has the same meaning as in the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982;

3. Requirement for the Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Road Closure, One-Way Streets, Short-Stay Parking Restrictions, Temporary Speed Limits and Temporary Right of Way Closures specified in Articles 4 to 13 of this Order

The prohibitions of waiting, loading and unloading, road closure, one-way streets, short-stay parking restrictions, temporary speed limits, and temporary Right of Way closures specified in Articles 4 to 13 of this Order are required to ensure public safety and efficient management of vehicular traffic during the "build" and "take down" phases and throughout the duration of the 2018 Scottish Open Golf Championship (12th to 15th July 2018) & 2018 Ladies Scottish Open Golf Championship (26th to 29th July 2018) event which will be contested at Gullane Golf Club, Gullane, East Lothian.

4. Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading in lengths of road specified in Schedule 1

Save as provided in Article 14 of this Order, no person shall throughout the duration of this Order, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload between 0700 hrs and 2200 hrs on either side (as specified on Schedule 1) and on any lengths of road in Gullane, Aberlady and North Berwick specified in Schedule 1 on the dates specified below. These restrictions shall come into operation on and between 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen at the discretion of the Chief Constable as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen. Only the (a) Gullane restrictions will be in effect during the Ladies Scottish Open Golf Championship (26th to 29th July 2018).

5. Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading in lengths of road specified in Schedule 2

No person shall throughout the duration of this Order, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload between 0700 hrs and 1100 hrs and between 1600 hrs and 2200 hrs on either side (as specified on Schedule 2) and on any lengths of road in Gullane, Aberlady, Drem, Longniddry or North Berwick specified in Schedule 2. Except where Schedule 6 applies. These restrictions shall come into operation at 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen. Only the (a) Gullane restrictions will be in effect during the Ladies Scottish Open Golf Championship (26th to 29th July 2018).

6. Prohibition of Waiting in lengths of road specified in Schedule 3

No person shall throughout the duration of this Order, except upon the direction or permission of a police constable or traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between 1100 hrs and 1600 hrs on either side (as specified on Schedule 3) and on any lengths of road in Gullane, Aberlady, Drem, Longniddry or North Berwick specified in Schedule 3. These restrictions shall come into operation at 0700 hrs on Wednesday 11th day of July and continue in force up to 2200 hrs on Monday 16th day of July two thousand and eighteen.

7. Prohibition of through vehicular access to lengths of road specified in Schedule 4

Save as provided in Article 15 of this Order the lengths of road in East Lothian specified in Schedule 4 shall be closed to through traffic, between 0700 hrs and 2200 hrs on the dates detailed below. These restrictions shall come into operation at 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen, as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen.

8. Alternative routes for the lengths of road closed to through traffic in Schedule 4

The alternative route for the closed roads (West Links Road) within East Lothian identified in Schedule 4 will be by way of Sandy Loan, Nisbet Road, and Hummel Road.

9. Restriction on vehicular travel direction on lengths of road specified in Schedule 5

Any vehicle travelling on any lengths of roads in Gullane specified in Schedule 5 shall follow the traffic flow in the specified One Way direction between 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen, as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen, as determined by and at the direction of the Chief Constable.

10. Introduction of short-stay parking in lengths of road specified in Schedule 6

Short stay (one hour) parking (no return within one hour) shall be introduced to those parts of roads in Gullane specified in Schedule 6, between 0700 hrs and 2200 hrs. These restrictions shall come into operation at 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen, as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen as directed by the Chief Constable.

11. Introduction of temporary 40mph speed limit on lengths of road specified in Schedule 7

Any vehicle travelling on any lengths of road specified in Schedule 7 shall travel at not more than 40mph between 0600 hrs on Sunday 1st July and 0000 hrs on Sunday 29th July two thousand and eighteen, as determined by and at the direction of the Chief Constable.

12. Introduction of temporary 20mph speed limit on lengths of road specified in Schedule 8

Any vehicle travelling on any lengths of road specified in Schedule 8 shall travel at not more than 20mph between 0600 hrs on Sunday 1st July and 0000 hrs on Sunday 29th July two thousand and eighteen, as determined by and at the direction of the Chief Constable.

13. Prohibition of access to lengths of Right of Way (Section 62 Roads (Scotland) Act 1984) specified in Schedule 9

The lengths of Right of Ways in East Lothian specified in Schedule 9 and shown in Appendix A, shall be closed. These restrictions shall come into operation at 0700 hrs Wednesday 11th July and 2200 hrs Monday 16th July two thousand and eighteen as well as between 0700 hrs Wednesday 25th July and 2200 hrs Monday 30th July two thousand and eighteen.

14. Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions specified in Schedule 1

Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall prevent a person in a vehicle from waiting, loading and unloading in any lengths of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle:

- (a) is a bus or coach waiting, dropping off or uplifting passengers using the "Public Park and Ride" and "Railway Station, North Berwick" parallel shuttle services in –
 - (1) Sandy Loan, Gullane, and
 - (2) Goose Green, Gullane
- (b) is a taxi dropping off or uplifting passengers in Goose Green, Gullane
- (c) is a bus or coach waiting, dropping off or uplifting passengers in Goose Green, Gullane.

15. Exemptions from Access Restrictions specified in Schedule 4

Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall prevent pedestrian or emergency access to any lengths of road referred to in that Article.

16. Variation of Existing Traffic Regulation Order

The County of East Lothian (Waiting Restrictions)(Gullane Village) Traffic Regulation Order 1974 will be varied so as to permit the restrictions on waiting as detailed in the Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 6 to apply daily during the hours specified. At all times, other than those stated, the restrictions imposed by the said 1974 Order will apply.

17. Duty to Move On

Notwithstanding any exemption contained in Articles 14 and 15 of the Order, the person in control of any vehicle waiting during the restricted or prohibited hours in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 6 shall move the vehicle on the instructions of a police constable in uniform, whenever such removal is required.

18. Use of Vehicle

No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place, or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services, unless they hold a street trader's licence in respect of such sale or hire.

SCHEDULE 1

Roads within East Lothian where waiting, loading and unloading is prohibited during the dates and times specified in Article 4 on both sides of the carriageway, unless stated otherwise below and unless otherwise directed by or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.

(a) Gullane

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the the west most speed restriction signs at Gullane in a north easterly then easterly direction, for a distance of 186 metres or thereby to a point 37 metres or thereby west of its junction with Sandy Loan.
- (2) Bank Buildings from its junction with Saltcoats Road, westwards for a distance of 145 metres or thereby on the south side only covering Summerside Place and Rosebery Place.
- (3) Brighton Terrace, for its entire length from its junction with Main Street southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
- (4) Goose Green Road (includes Hopetoun View) for its entire length, from its junction with Main Street northwards, eastwards, southwards and westwards, for a distance of 638 metres or thereby.
- (5) Saltcoats Road for its entire length, from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 400 metres or thereby.
- (6) Sandy Loan for its entire length from its junction with Main Street, northwards for a distance of 432 metres or thereby
- (7) Templar Lane from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby on the east side only
- (8) Templar Lane from a point 93 metres or thereby south from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 12 metres or thereby on the east side only.
- (9) Templar Lane from its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby on the west side only,
- (10) Templar Lane from a point 30 metres or thereby south its junction with Main Street, southwards for a distance of 75 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (11) Templar Place for its entire length from its junction with Saltcoats Road, westwards to its junction with Templar Lane for a distance of 92 metres or thereby
- (12) West Links Road, for its entire length from its junction with the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198), westwards for a distance of 298 metres or thereby

(b) Aberlady

- (1) All that part of the High Street, Aberlady from its junction with the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) eastwards to its junction with the Gardens, Aberlady, on the north side only.

(c) North Berwick

- (1) Dirleton Avenue from its junction with Links Road westwards for a distance of 18 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (2) Dirleton Avenue from its junction with Links Road eastwards for a distance of 18 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (3) Dirleton Avenue from its junction with Ware Road westwards for a distance of 32 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (4) Dirleton Avenue from its junction with Ware Road eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (5) Ibris Road from its junction with May Terrace southwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby, on the west side only.
- (6) Ibris Road from its junction with May Terrace southwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (7) Links Road from its junction with Dirleton Avenue southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the west side only.
- (8) Links Road from its junction with Dirleton Avenue southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (9) Links Road from its junction with May Terrace northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the west side only.
- (10) Links Road from its junction with May Terrace northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (11) May Terrace from its junction with Ware Road eastwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the north side only.
- (12) May Terrace from its junction with Ware Road eastwards for a distance of 59 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (13) May Terrace from its junction with Links Road westwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the north side only.
- (14) May Terrace from its junction with Links Road eastwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby, on the north side only.
- (15) May Terrace from its junction with Ibris Road eastwards, south eastwards then north eastwards for a distance of 130 metres or thereby, on the south side only.
- (16) Ware Road from its junction with Dirleton Avenue southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the west side only.
- (17) Ware Road from its junction with Dirleton Avenue southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (18) Ware Road from its junction with May Terrace northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (19) Ware Road from its junction with May Terrace southwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby, on the east side only.
- (20) Ware Road from a point opposite the south kerbline of May Terrace northwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby, on the west side only.



SCHEDULE 2

Roads in Gullane, Aberlady and Longniddry where waiting, loading and unloading is prohibited during the dates and times specified in Article 5 on both sides of the carriageway, unless stated otherwise below and unless otherwise directed by or with the permission of a police constable in uniform. Except where Schedule 7 applies.

(a) Gullane

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the C108 (Avenue Road) junction in an easterly direction, through Gullane, to its junction with the B1345 (Dirleton Toll) a distance of 5246 metres or thereby but excluding that part listed in Schedule 1.
- (2) Broadgait (East), from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with Main Street, for its entire length a distance of 240 metres or thereby.
- (3) East Links Road, from a point 50 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a southerly direction, for a distance of 245 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (4) East Links Road, from a point 50 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a easterly direction, for a distance of 15 metres or thereby on the north side only.
- (5) East Links Road, from a point 115 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a southerly direction, for a distance of 55 metres or thereby to a point adjacent to the north kerbline of the Hall Crescent junction on the east side only.
- (6) East Links Road, from a point adjacent to the south kerbline of the Hall Crescent junction in a southerly direction, for a distance of 113 metres or thereby on the east side only.
- (7) Erskine Road from its junction with Broadgait to it's junction with Marine Road in a northerly then westerly direction, for its entire length a distance of 550 metres or thereby.
- (8) Hall Crescent, from its junction with Main Street to it's junction with East Links Road in a southerly then westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 233 metres or thereby.
- (9) Hamilton Crescent, from its junction with Hall Crescent in a southerly, easterly then northerly direction, to its junction with Hamilton Road, on the west side only, a distance of 238 metres or thereby.
- (10) Hamilton Crescent, from its junction with Hamilton Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the east side only.
- (11) Hamilton Road, on the south side only, from its junction with Hall Crescent in an easterly direction, to a point 14 metres east of its junction with Hamilton Crescent, a distance of 122 metres or thereby.
- (12) Hamilton Road, on the north side only, from a point 5 metres west of the west kerbline of Hamilton Crescent in an easterly direction, a distance of 143 metres or thereby.
- (13) Hill Road, from its junction with Sandy Loan in an westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 514 metres or thereby.
- (14) Hopetoun Park, from its junction with Erskine Road in an northerly direction for its entire length a distance of 140 metres or thereby.

- (15) Hummel Road, from its junction with Hill Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with West Links Road for its entire length a distance of 326 metres or thereby.
- (16) Marine Terrace, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a easterly direction, to its junction with Marine Road for its entire length a distance of 238 metres or thereby.
- (17) Marine Road from its junction with Marine Terrace in a southerly direction, to its junction with Goose Green Road for its entire length a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
- (18) Middleshot Road, on the east side only, from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with Main Street for its entire length a distance of 337 metres or thereby.
- (19) Middleshot Road from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (20) Middleshot Road from its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (21) Nisbet Road, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a westerly direction, to its junction with Hummel Road for its entire length a distance of 246 metres or thereby.
- (22) The Paddock, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a northerly direction for its entire length on the west side a distance of 210 metres or thereby.
- *(23) Whim Road, from its junction with Hummel Road in a westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 428 metres or thereby.

(b) Aberlady

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from a point 42 metres north of the Sea Wynd / High Street junction, southwards then westwards on Main Street (A198), for a distance of 185 metres or thereby, on the east and south sides.
- (2) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from a point 42 metres north of the Sea Wynd / High Street junction, southwards then westwards on Main Street (A198), for a distance of 105 metres or thereby, on the west and north sides.

(c) Longniddry

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) from its junction with the east end of Kitchener Crescent, eastwards then northwards for a distance of 95 metres or thereby on Wemyss Terrace, on the north and west sides.
- (2) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) from lamp standard JA64 on Wemyss Terrace, southwards then eastwards on the Longniddry – Drem Road (B1377) to lamp standard JA45, a distance of 121 metres or thereby, on the east and north sides.
- (3) All that part of the Longniddry – Drem Road (B1377) from opposite lamp standard JA45, westwards to opposite the junction with the east end of Kitchener Crescent, a distance of 152 metres or thereby, on the south side only.

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SCHEDULE 3

Roads in Gullane, Aberlady and Longniddry where waiting is prohibited during the dates and times specified in Article 6 on both sides of the carriageway, unless stated otherwise below and unless otherwise directed by or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.

(a) Gullane

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the C108 (Avenue Road) junction in an easterly direction, through Gullane, to its junction with the B1345 (Dirleton Toll) but excluding that part listed in Schedule 1.
- (2) Broadgait (East), from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with Main Street, for its entire length a distance of 240 metres or thereby.
- (3) East Links Road, from a point 50 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a southerly direction, for a distance of 245 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (4) East Links Road, from a point 50 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a easterly direction, for a distance of 15 metres or thereby on the north side only.
- (5) East Links Road, from a point 115 metres or thereby south of the Brighton Terrace junction with Main Street in a southerly direction, for a distance of 55 metres or thereby to a point adjacent to the north kerbline of the Hall Crescent junction on the east side only.
- (6) East Links Road, from a point adjacent to the south kerbline of the Hall Crescent junction in a southerly direction, for a distance of 113 metres or thereby on the east side only.
- (7) Erskine Road from its junction with Broadgait to its junction with Marine Road in a northerly then westerly direction, for its entire length a distance of 550 metres or thereby.
- (8) Hall Crescent, from its junction with Main Street to its junction with East Links Road in a southerly then westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 233 metres or thereby.
- (9) Hamilton Crescent, from its junction with Hall Crescent in a southerly, easterly then northerly direction, to its junction with Hamilton Road, on the west side only, a distance of 238 metres or thereby.
- (10) Hamilton Crescent, from its junction with Hamilton Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the east side only.
- (11) Hamilton Road, on the south side only, from its junction with Hall Crescent in an easterly direction, to a point 14 metres east of its junction with Hamilton Crescent, a distance of 122 metres or thereby.
- (12) Hamilton Road, on the north side only, from a point 5 metres west of the west kerbline of Hamilton Crescent in an easterly direction, a distance of 143 metres or thereby.
- (13) Hill Road, from its junction with Sandy Loan in an westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 514 metres or thereby.
- (14) Hopetoun Park, from its junction with Erskine Road in an northerly direction for its entire length a distance of 140 metres or thereby.
- (15) Hummel Road, from its junction with Hill Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with West Links Road for its entire length a distance of 326 metres or thereby.

- (16) Marine Terrace, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a easterly direction, to its junction with Marine Road for its entire length a distance of 238 metres or thereby.
- (17) Marine Road from its junction with Marine Terrace in a southerly direction, to its junction with Goose Green Road for its entire length a distance of 200 metres or thereby .
- (18) Middleshot Road, on the east side only, from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction, to its junction with Main Street for its entire length a distance of 337 metres or thereby.
- (19) Middleshot Road from its junction with Erskine Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (20) Middleshot Road from its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres or thereby on the west side only.
- (21) Nisbet Road, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a westerly direction, to its junction with Hummel Road for its entire length a distance of 246 metres or thereby.
- (22) The Paddock, from its junction with Sandy Loan in a northerly direction for its entire length on the west side a distance of 210 metres or thereby .
- (23) Whim Road, from its junction with Hummel Road in a westerly direction for its entire length a distance of 428 metres or thereby.

(b) Aberlady

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from a point 42 metres north of the Sea Wynd / High Street junction, southwards then westwards on Main Street (A198), for a distance of 185 metres or thereby, on the east and south sides.
- (2) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from a point 42 metres north of the Sea Wynd / High Street junction, southwards then westwards on Main Street (A198), for a distance of 105 metres or thereby, on the west and north sides.

(c) Longniddry

- (21) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) from its junction with the east end of Kitchener Crescent, eastwards then northwards for a distance of 95 metres or thereby on Wemyss Terrace, on the north and west sides.
- (22) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) from lamp standard JA64 on Wemyss Terrace, southwards then eastwards on the Longniddry – Drem Road (B1377) to lamp standard JA45, a distance of 121 metres or thereby, on the east and north sides.
- (23) All that part of the Longniddry – Drem Road (B1377) from opposite lamp standard JA45, westwards to opposite the junction with the east end of Kitchener Crescent, a distance of 152 metres or thereby, on the south side only.



SCHEDULE 4

Roads within East Lothian which will be closed to through traffic during the dates and times specified in Article 7, unless otherwise directed by or with the permission of a police constable in uniform. Pedestrian, cyclist and emergency vehicle access will be maintained.

- (1) West Links Road, Gullane from its junction with the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) westwards to the junction with Hummel Road, a distance of 165 metres or thereby.
- (2) Goose Green Road, Gullane from its junction with Hopetoun View northwest to the Coach House, and for a distance of 100 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 5

Roads within Gullane where a One-Way direction of traffic flow will be introduced during the dates and times specified in Article 9, and determined at the discretion of the Chief Constable.

- (1) One-Way southbound - All that part of Brighton Terrace and East Links Road from it's junction with Main Street (Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198)) southwards to the junction with Hall Crescent a distance of 220 metres or thereby.
- (2) One-Way northbound - All that part of Sandy Loan from it's junction with Main Street (Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198)) northwards to the junction with The Paddock a distance of 220 metres or thereby.
- (3) One-Way northbound - All that part of Saltcoats Road from it's junction with Main Street (Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198)) southwards to the entrance to Saltcoats Farm a distance of 398 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 6

Roads within Gullane where short stay (1 hour) parking (no return within 1 hour) will be permitted during the hours and dates specified in Article 10, at the direction of the Chief Constable.

- (1) That part of the existing designated parallel short stay parking (3 spaces / 15 metres) on the south side of Main Street (Bank Buildings), from a point 28 metres west of the west kerbline of Saltcoats Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.
- (2) That part of existing designated parallel short stay parking (8 spaces / 43 metres) on the north side of Main Street (Stanley Road), from a point 28 metres east of the east kerbline of Goose Green Road in a easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 7

Roads within East Lothian on which a temporary 40mph speed limit will be introduced during the dates and times stated in Article 11.

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the west most speed restriction signs at Gullane in a south westerly direction, for a distance of 750 metres or thereby
- (2) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the east most speed restriction signs at Gullane in an easterly direction, for a distance of 725 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 8

Roads within East Lothian on which a temporary 20mph speed limit will be introduced during the dates and times stated in Article 12.

- (1) All that part of the Prestonpans – North Berwick Road (A198) extending from the west most speed restriction signs at Gullane in an easterly direction, for a distance of 636 metres or thereby to a point 78 metres or thereby east of its junction with Hall Crescent.

SCHEDULE 9

Right of Ways (RoW) on Gullane Golf Course, East Lothian which will be closed during the dates and times specified in Article 13, unless otherwise directed by or with the permission of a police constable in uniform.

- (1) The most northern part of the Aberlady Bay car park to Whim Road, Gullane RoW extending from it's junction with the West Links Road to Hill Road RoW westwards for a distance of 1,054 metres or thereby to a point where it turns due south. An alternative diversion will be available via the existing footpath network around the north and west boundary of Gullane Golf Club.
- (2) All that part of the Hill Road to Gullane Bents (via Maggie's Loup) RoW extending westwards from it's junction with the Hill Road to The Bents RoW for a distance of 670 metres or thereby to Maggie's Loup. An alternative diversion will be available via the existing footpath network to the north.
