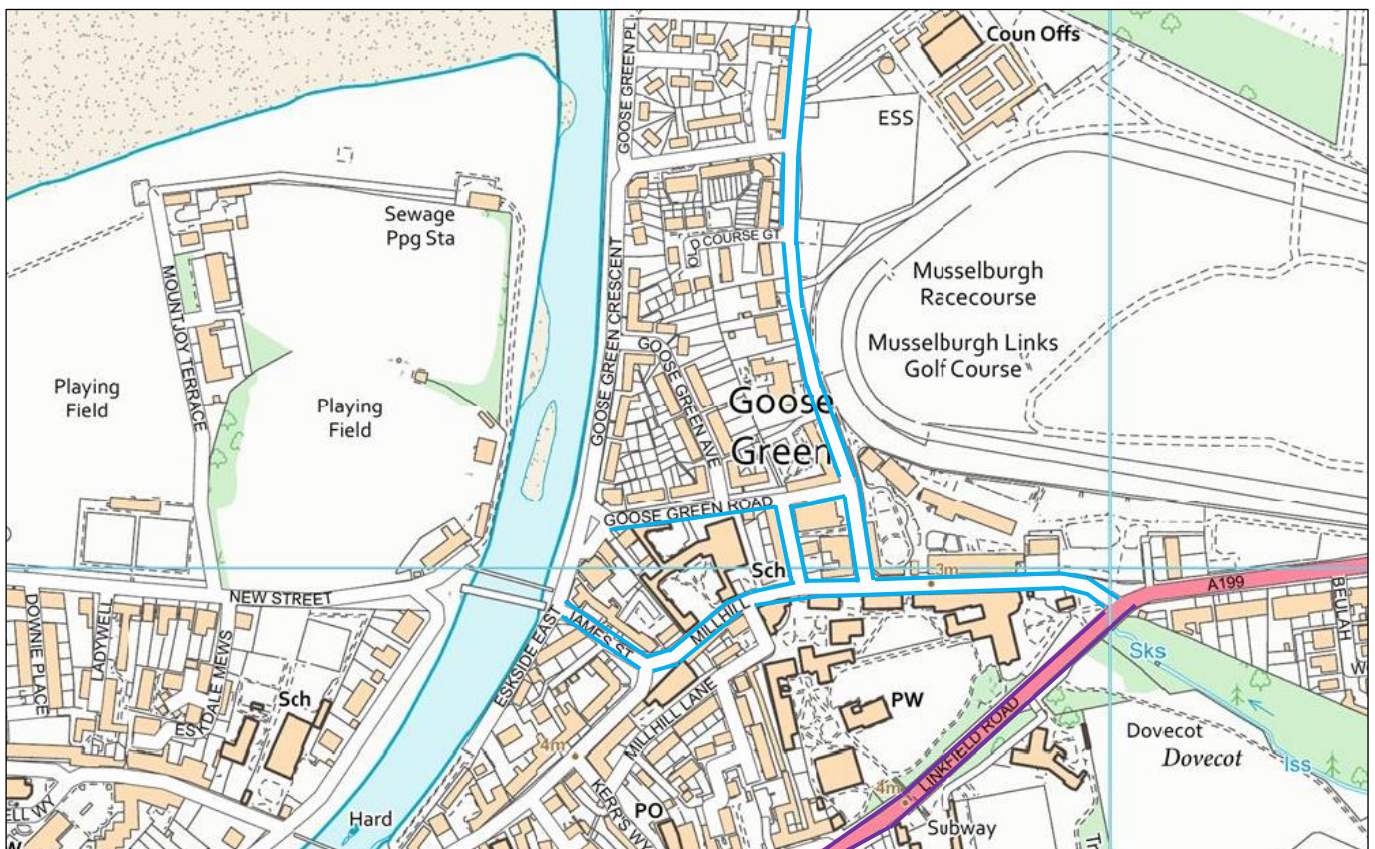


ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 16

	Hope Place	One side leading onto Ravensheugh Road
	The Paddock (part)	Both sides from Balcarres place to Balcarres Road

Special Events – Additional Restrictions 1 st January 30 th March 1 st June 2 nd August 14 th and 15 th September		
All Special Events	Millhill Road	Crowd barrier to be placed from kerb to edge of first speed bump on racecourse side between Linkfield Road to Balcarres Road to allow additional crowd queuing space. Two-way traffic will remain in place with police and / or security teams overseeing.
	Linkfield Road	Parking restrictions both sides from Loretto Corner to Musselburgh High Street (St Peter's Episcopal Church)
