The East Renfrewshire Council (Divernia Way, Barrhead) (Temporary Restriction to Use of Road) Order 2017



On the 2nd August 2017 East Renfrewshire Council made the above named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, in terms of which use of a section of the following road, by the undernoted classes of vehicle will be prohibited within the stated period of time. (Note that the order will be in effect only when indicated by the display of appropriate signs in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016).

Effects of the Restrictions:	TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
Names of Roads:	DIVERNIA WAY, BARRHEAD
Extents of Closures:	BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH HAWTHORN DRIVE TO, AND INCLUDING, ITS JUNCTION WITH OAKBANK DRIVE. WORKS WILL BE CARIED OUT IN TWO PHASES TO ALLOW ACCESS FROM MAPLE DRIVE AND OAKBANK DRIVE VIA DIVERNIA WAY
Reason for the Restrictions:	TO FACILITATE ESSENTIAL CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING
Duration of Restrictions:	FROM MONDAY 21 st AUGUST 2017 UNTIL FRIDAY 1 ST SEPTEMBER 2017 OR ON COMPLETION OF THE WORKS IF SOONER
Classes of Vehicle Prohibited:	ALL - EXCEPT EMERGENCY VEHICLES ATTENDING AN INCIDENT AND VEHICLES ASSOCIATED WITH THE WORKS. (Vehicular access to property within the extents of the closure will be permitted by the contractor on site only when it is possible to do so in conjunction with the works going on at the time. Pedestrian access will be unaffected).



Alternative Routes: OAKBANK DRIVE – FENWICK DRIVE – ROEBANK DRIVE – NEWTON AVENUE – DIVERNIA WAY AND VICE-VERSA
