

The East Renfrewshire Council
(A77 Ayr Road)
(Temporary 30mph Speed Limit)
Order 2021



On the 11 December 2020 East Renfrewshire Council made the above named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, in terms of which the following road by the undernoted classes of vehicle will be restricted when indicated by the appropriate Road traffic Sign.

(Note that the order will be in effect only when indicated by the display of appropriate signs in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016).

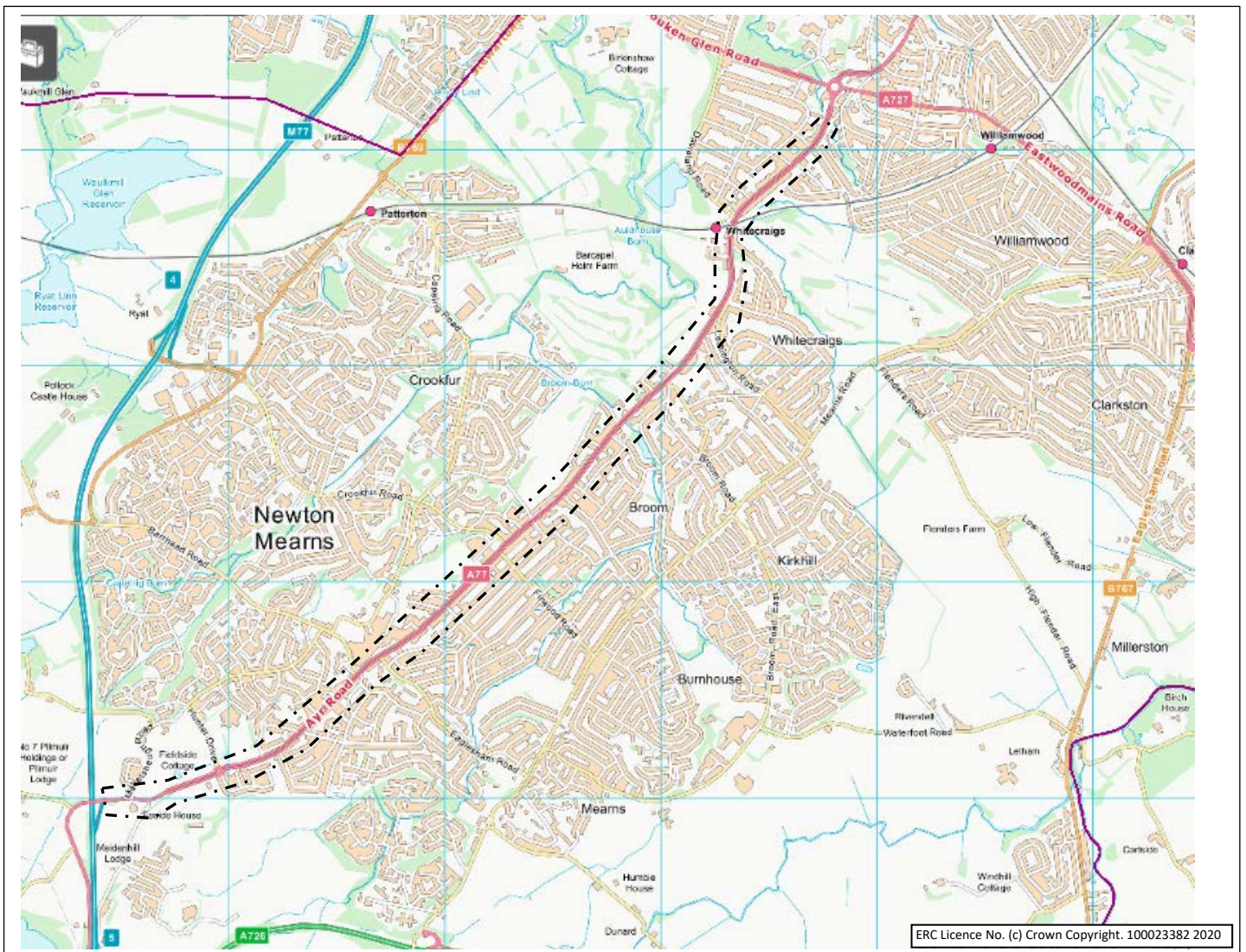
Effects of the Restrictions: 30mph SPEED LIMIT (REDUCED FROM THE CURRENT 40mph SPEED LIMIT)

Reason for the Restrictions: IN THE INTEREST OF ROAD SAFETY DUE TO SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES MADE TO THE ROAD LAYOUT WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF SEGREGATED CYCLE LANES ON SECTIONS OF THE CARRIAGEWAY OF THE A77 AYR ROAD.

Names of Road: A77 AYR ROAD (NORTH AND SOUTH BOUND CARRIAGEWAYS:
Between a point 90m or thereby west of the western kerbline of Malletsheugh Road and a point 60 metres or thereby south of the inscribed circle of Eastwood Toll roundabout, where the current 40mph speed limit commences/terminates, a distance of 4,880 metres or thereby.

Duration of Restrictions: COMMENCING 00:01 ON 5 JANUARY 2021 FOR A MAXIMUM DURATION OF 18 MONTHS AS PERMITTED BY LEGISLATION.

Classes of Vehicle Restricted: ALL - EXCEPT EMERGENCY VEHICLES WHILST ATTENDING AN INCIDENT.
