

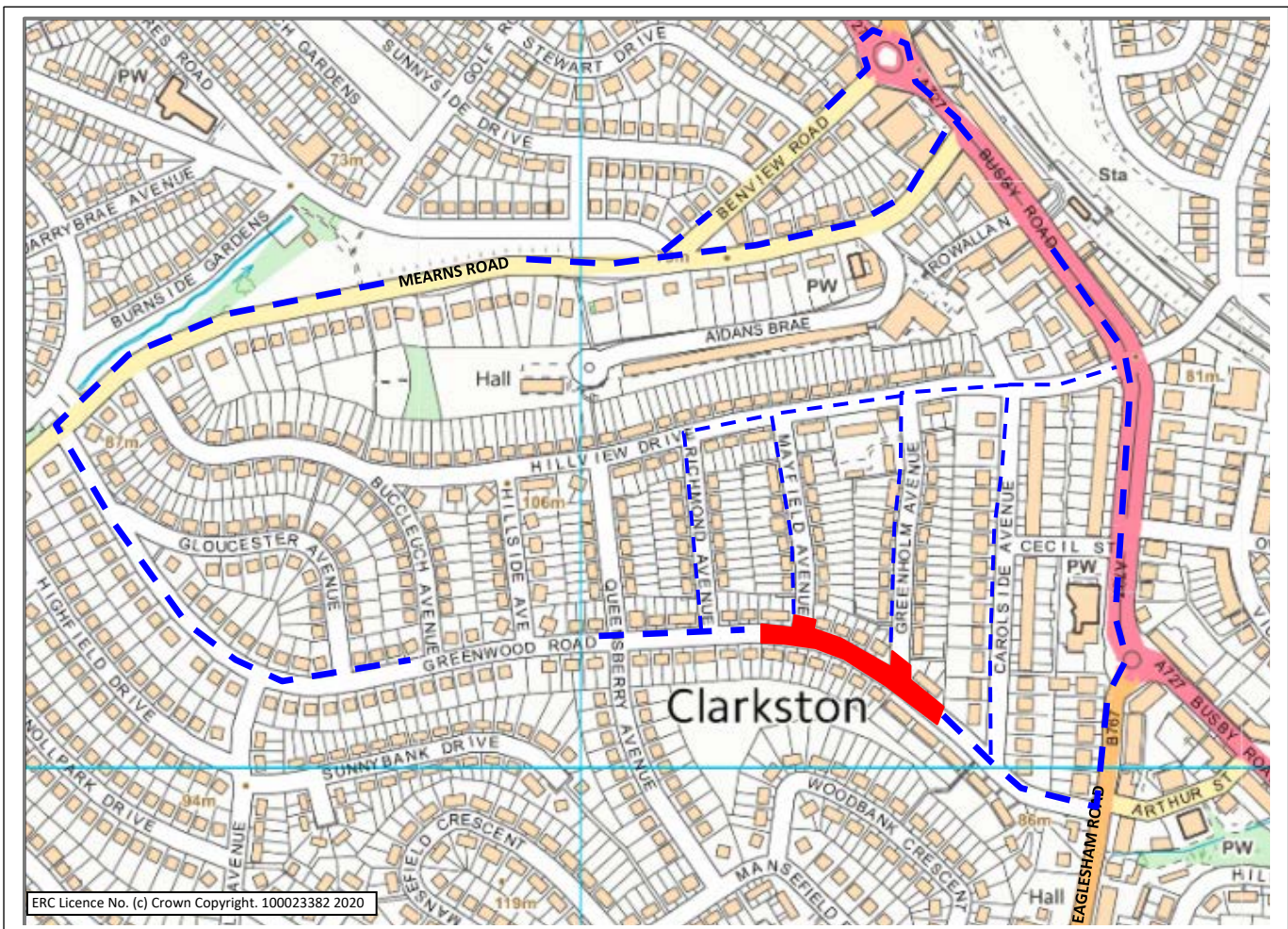
The East Renfrewshire Council
(Greenwood Road, Clarkston)
(Temporary Restriction to Use of Road)
Order 2021



On the 20 November 2020 the Council made the above named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, in terms of which use of a section of the following road, by the undernoted classes of vehicle will be prohibited within the stated period of time.

(Note that the order will be in effect only when indicated by the display of appropriate signs in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016).

- Effects of the Restrictions:** ROAD CLOSURE
- Road affected:** GREENWOD ROAD, CLARKSTON:
Between a point 30 metres or thereby west of its junction with Mayfield Avenue and a point 45 meters or thereby southeast of its junction with Greenholm Avenue,
- Reason for the Restrictions:** TO FACILITATE THE SAFE INSTALLATION OF A NEW CULVERT AS PART OF ESSENTIAL FLOOD PREVENTION WORKS FOR SCOTTISH WATER
- Anticipated Duration of Works:** 26 WEEKS - FROM THURSDAY 7 JANUARY UNTIL FRIDAY 9 JULY 2021
- Max Duration of Restrictions:** THE RESTRICTIONS AUTHORISED BY THIS ORDER WILL REMAIN VALID FOR A MAXIMUM PERIOD OF 18 MONTHS FROM THE DATE THE ORDER WAS MADE, AS PRESCRIBED BY LEGISLATION.
- Classes of Vehicle Prohibited:** ALL - EXCEPT VEHICLES ASSOCIATED WITH THE WORKS.
ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES ATTENDING AN INCIDENT AND VEHICULAR ACCESS TO PROPERTIES WITHIN THE EXTENTS OF THE CLOSURE MAY BE PERMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR ON SITE ONLY WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE TO DO SO IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE WORKS GOING ON AT THE TIME. PEDESTRAIN ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
- Alternative Route:** GREENWOOD RD – EAGLESHAM RD – BUSBY RD – MEARNS RD – GREENWOD RD AND VICE-VERSA
