(7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Restriction)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021



The East Renfrewshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The East Renfrewshire Council Sergeantlaw Rd & Shilford Rd, Neilston (7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Restriction) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021” and comes into effect on 12 April 2021 and will remain in effect for a maximum period of 18 months.

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

“**maximum gross weight**”, in relation to a motor vehicle or trailer, means the weight of the vehicle laden with the heaviest load which it is constructed or adapted to carry,

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight from being driven on the section of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to be driven on any of the sections of the roads referred to in the Schedule to this Order:-

(i) if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the length of the road so referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of the road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

(ii) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers and duties and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes ;

- (iii) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of servicing properties or fields where the access to these properties or fields is located within the sections of roads restricted.

Schedule

7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Restriction

Road within the boundary of East Renfrewshire Council	Section of Road Affected
Sergeantlaw Road, Neilston	From its junction with Greenfieldmuir Road Neilston to its southwestern junction with the B775 Gleniffer Road, a distance of approximately 3,000 metres (1.9 miles) or thereby.
Shilford Road, Neilston	From its junction with the B775 Gleniffer Road to its junction with Fereneze Road, Neilston, a distance of approximately 2,160 metres (1.3 miles) or thereby.
