

**THE EASTRENFRESHIRE COUNCIL
(FIELD ROAD & WOODYETT ROAD, BUSBY)
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION TO USE OF ROAD
ORDER 2022**



On the 1st December 2022 the Council made the above named Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, in terms of which waiting by the undernoted classes of vehicles on the following section of road(s) will be restricted within the stated period of time.

Note that the order will be in effect only when indicated by the display of appropriate signs in accordance with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

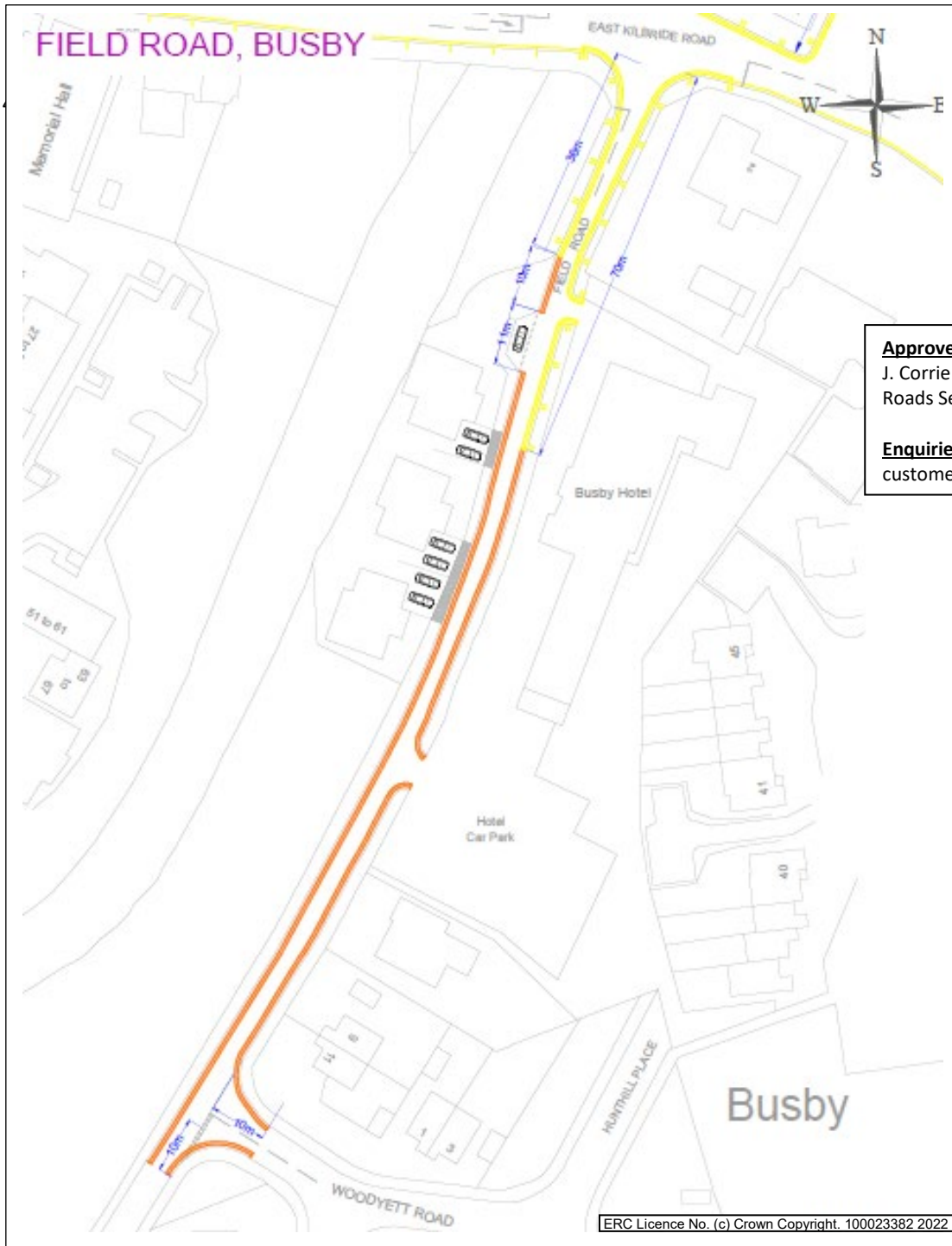
Location: FIELD ROAD & WOODYETT ROAD, BUSBY

Restriction: NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Maximum Duration: 18 MONTHS – FROM MONDAY 5th DECEMBER 2022.

Reason for Restriction: IN THE INTERESTS OF PUBLIC SAFETY DUE TO THE LIKELIHOOD OF DANGER CAUSED BY INAPPROPRIATE PARKING OVER THESE SECTIONS OF ROAD AND IN ORDER TO ENSURE SAFE PASSAGE FOR ALL ROAD USERS ALONG THE LENGTHS OF ROAD, WHICH INCLUDES THE FOOTWAYS & VERGES.

Vehicles Restricted: ALL VEHICLES EXCEPT THOSE ASSOCIATED WITH ESSENTIAL WORKS ON OR NEAR THE AFFECTED ROADS AND EMERGENCY SERVICE VEHICLES ATTENDING AN INCIDENT.
