## THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (BO'NESS CHILDREN'S FAIR FESTIVAL) (SPECIAL EVENT) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)(No.TTRO/878) ORDER 2016

Falkirk Council make the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 2(2), 4(1) and 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the 1984 Act), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with Section 16A(2) of the 1984 Act Falkirk Council are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the Bo'ness Children's Fair Festival and enabling members of the public to watch this event.

In accordance with Section 16A(3) of the 1984 Act Falkirk Council are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with Section 16A(8) of the 1984 Act Falkirk Council have had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

## Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as "The Falkirk Council (Bo'ness Children's Fair Festival)(Special Event)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)(No.TTRO/878) Order 2016" and shall come into force on 24/06/16 at 08:00hrs and ceases to have effect until the parade passes on 24/06/16.

#### Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to article 3, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs prescribed in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016

## **Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

3. This Order does not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance, or police purposes, or an official vehicle while being used in connection with the holding of the Bo'ness Children's Fair Festival

b)	From 09.00 to 13:00, Linlithgow Road from Dean Road to junction with Church Wynd. Church Wynd from Linlithgow Road to Seaview Place Roundabout.	
c)	From 09:00 until after the parade passes, Dean Road from Linlithgow Road to Erngath Road.	
d)	From 11:00 until after the parade passes, Seaview Place Roundabout, Seaview Place, North Main Street, Main Street, Links Road, Grangepans to Cowdenhill Road, Cowdenhill Road, Philpingstone Road between Cowdenhill Road and Grange Terrace, Grange Loan from Philpingstone Road to Harbour Road, Harbour Road from Grange Loan to Grahamsdyke Road, Grahamsdyke Road from Harbour Road to Dean Road.	
e)	From 11:00 until after the parade passes, A904 at the Drum Roundabout – local access will be permitted as required.	
f)	From 11:00 until after the parade passes, A904, Kinneil Road at Castlehill – local access will be permitted as required.

During Fair Day, all vehicular traffic within Bo'ness will be subject to direction from the police and restrictions placed by Traffic Management company Amey. Amey will remove all physical restrictions as soon as it is practical and safe to do so after the procession has passed.
