- 1. This Order may be cited as "Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Space for Disabled Persons) (No. 463) Order 2008 and shall come into operation on the First day of May, Two Thousand and Eight.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The effect of this Order will be to designate the section of road described in the Schedule hereto and shown on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto as a parking space for disabled persons' vehicles.
- 4. In this Order "disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying, in the relevant position, a disabled person's badge issued by a local authority in exercise of its powers under S21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970.


