THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (ON-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS)(REVOCATION NO. 217) ORDER 2018

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons)(Revocation No. 217) Order 2018” and shall come into operation on the 8 day of November, Two Thousand and Eighteen.
2. The following Order is hereby revoked:-

The Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Space For Disabled Persons) (No.27) Order 2000.
3. The effect of this Order will be to remove the designated sections of road described in the Schedule hereto as a parking space for disabled persons vehicles.

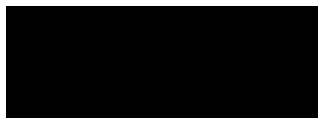

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under Section 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Space for Disabled Persons) (No.27) Order 2000 and shall come into operation on the 30 day of November, Two Thousand.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The effect of this Order will be to designate the section of road described in the Schedule hereto and shown on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto as a parking space for disabled persons' vehicles.
4. In this Order "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 1991;

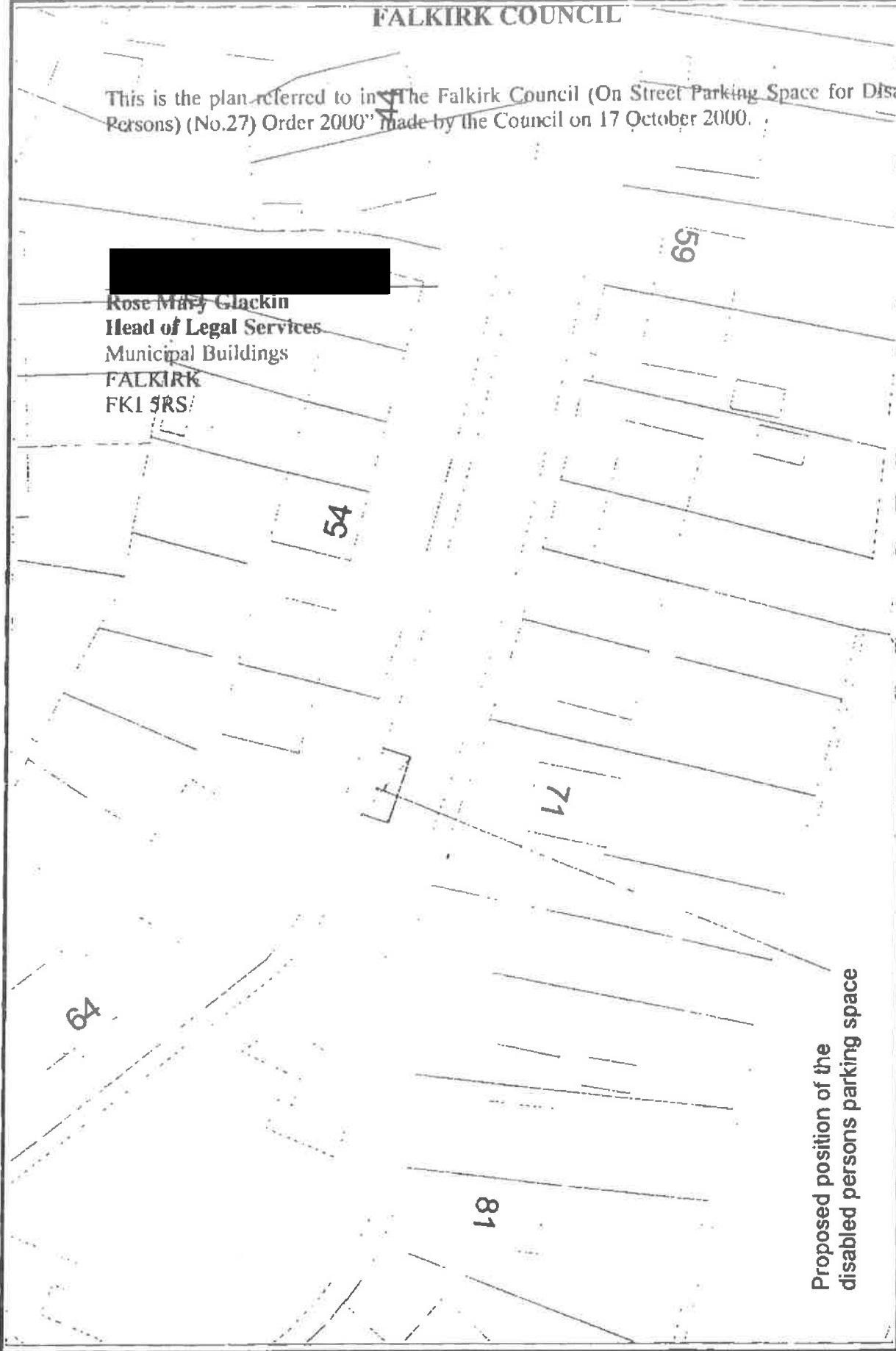
