**THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (MERCHISTON ROAD, FALKIRK)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)  
(NO.TTRO/1723) ORDER 2019**

The Council has made the above named Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to temporarily prohibit traffic on Merchiston Road, Falkirk from 07.30 hours on 18/11/19 until 17.00 hours on 29/11/19. The prohibition is to allow carriageway surfacing work to be carried out safely.

2. This Order temporarily closes Merchiston Road Falkirk from Merchiston Avenue to access to concrete paving supply plant.
3. The alternative route is: Merchiston Road – A9 – A9 Rosebank Roundabout – A9 – A9 Merchiston Roundabout – Merchiston Road and vice versa.

### THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (MERCHISTON ROAD, FALKIRK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (NO.TTRO/1723) ORDER 2019

Falkirk Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) and (4) as read with Section 2(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, being satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of Road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths, hereby make the following Order:-

#### **Citation, commencement and cessation**

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The Falkirk Council (Merchiston Road, Falkirk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (TTRO/1723) Order 2019" and shall come into force from 07.30 hours on 18/11/19 until 17.00 hours on 29/11/19 or until completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

#### **Interpretation**

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **Temporary Prohibition on Use of a Road**

- (3) Subject to article 4, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of Road and during the period(s) specified in the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

#### **Exemption for Emergency and Works Vehicles**

- (4) Article 3 does not apply to a vehicle while used in an emergency for Scottish Fire and Rescue Service; Maritime and Coastguard Agency; Scottish Ambulance Service; or Police Scotland purposes; or a vehicle whilst being used for carrying out the works.
