	Locations of Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons Vehicles to be Removed
York Street, Falkirk	On the north side of York Street from the projected east boundary line of 51 York Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.
	On the northeast side of York Street from the projected west boundary line of 65 York Street in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.
	On the southwest side of York Street in the parking layby from the projected north boundary line of 46 York Street in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 3.6 metres or thereby.
	On the south side of York Street from the projected east boundary line of 55 York Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 metres or thereby.


