THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (FALKIRK AREA SCHOOLS)(PART-TIME 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)(AMENDMENT)(TRO20/020) ORDER 2020

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Falkirk Council (Falkirk Area Schools)(Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit)(Amendment)(TRO20/020) Order 2020” and shall come into operation on the 10 day of December, Two Thousand and Twenty.
2. This Order amends The Falkirk Council (Falkirk Area Schools)(Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2005, as amended by The Falkirk Council (Falkirk Area Schools)(Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit)(amendment) Order 2008 through the extension of the 20mph zone in the vicinity of Kinnaird Primary School in the Schedule.
3. A part-time speed limit of 20 miles per hour is hereby imposed on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order on the plan annexed. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour during the time period wherein the restriction applies, as indicated by the activation of the electronic part-time traffic signals on said road.

SCHEDULE

Kinnaird Primary School

Ewing Way

Both Sides - from the projected southern kerbline of Tryst Park, in a southerly direction for a distance of 8 metres or thereby.

Endrick Court

Both Sides - From the projected western kerbline of Melville Crescent, in a westerly direction for a distance of 11 metres or thereby.

Melville Crescent

Both Sides - From the projected northern kerbline of Tryst Park, in a northerly direction for a distance of 97 metres or thereby.

Gowkhill Place

Both Sides - From the projected southern kerbline of McIntyre Avenue, in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 15 metres or thereby.

McIntyre Avenue

Both Sides - from a point 91 metres west of the projected western kerbline of Muir Drive, in a generally easterly direction to the point where it meets the roundabout at McCartney Road, a distance of 139 metres or thereby.

Kinnaird Village Retail Access

Both Sides - from the projected southeastern kerbline of McIntyre Avenue, in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 5 metres or thereby.

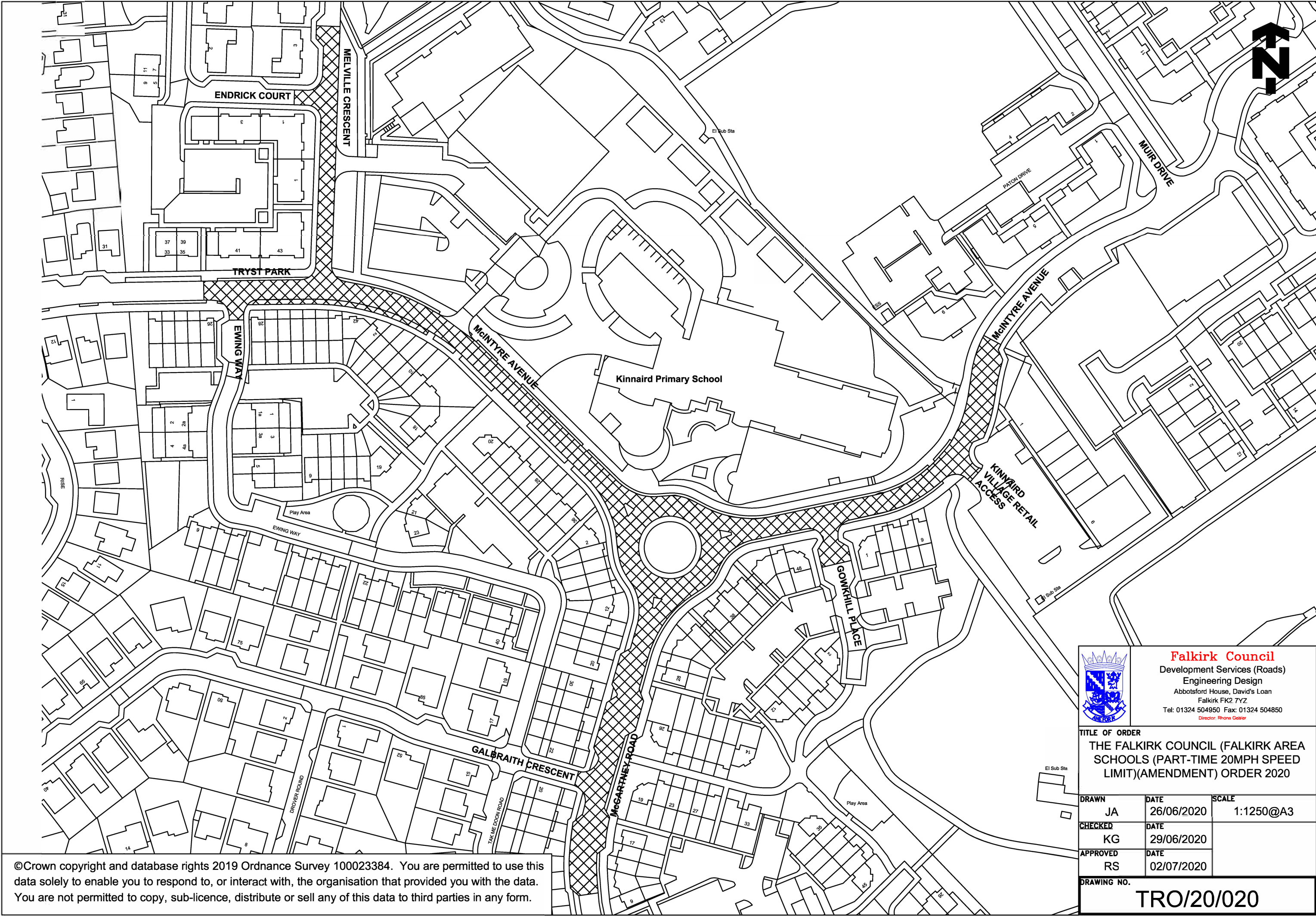
