THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (ON-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS) (REVOCATION NO. 727)(TRO/20/041)(MOY COURT, GRANGEMOUTH) ORDER 20_

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons)(Revocation No. 727)(TRO/20/041)(Moy Court, Grangemouth) Order 2020” and shall come into operation on the ____ day of ____, Two Thousand and ____.
2. The following Order is hereby revokes The Falkirk Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2018 insofar as it relates to the disabled persons parking bay located outside block 1 to 6 Moy Court, Grangemouth as indicated on plan AN48.
3. The effect of this Order will be to remove the designated sections of road described in the Schedule hereto as a parking space for disabled persons vehicles.
