THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (ON-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS) (REVOCATION NO. 722) (TRO/20/034) (FORTH AVENUE, LARBERT) ORDER 2020

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”) and of other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons)(Revocation No. 722)(TRO/20/034)(47 Forth Avenue, Larbert) Order 2020” and shall come into operation on the 8 day of April, Two Thousand and Twenty one.
2. The following Order is hereby revoked:-

“The Falkirk Council (On-street Parking Space for Disabled Persons) (No. TRO/DB/19/095) Order 2020”.
3. The effect of this Order will be to remove the designated sections of road described in the Schedule hereto as a parking space for disabled persons vehicles.
