THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (ON-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR DISABLED PERSONS REVOCATION) (VARIOUS STREETS NO 4) ORDER 2021

Falkirk Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "Falkirk Council (On-Street Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons Revocation)(Various Streets No 4) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the 11 day of August, Two Thousand and Twenty Two.
- 2. This Order hereby revokes The Falkirk Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Decriminalised Parking Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2018 insofar as it relates to the disabled persons parking bays described in the schedule as indicated on plans listed in the schedule.
- The effect of this Order will be to remove the designated sections of road described in the Schedule hereto as a parking space for disabled persons vehicles.

Glenview Avenue, Banknock TRO/21/028 K53 Revocation No. 758 On the west side of Langlees Street from the projected north building line of 43 Langlees Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres or thereby.

On the south side of Barleyhill from the projected west building line of 32 Barleyhill in a easterly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres or thereby.

On the west side of Glenview Avenue at the north end of the layby from a point 2 metres north of the projected north building line of 15 Glenview Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 3.6 metres or thereby.




Statement of Reasons for Making the Order


