THE FALKIRK COUNCIL (A9 LAURIESTON BYPASS) (TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION) (No.TTRO/1900) ORDER 2024

Falkirk Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1) and (4) as read with Section 2(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, being satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be restricted or prohibited as hereinafter provided because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation, commencement and cessation

- (1) This Order may be cited as "The Falkirk Council (A9 Laurieston Bypass) (Temporary Speed Restriction) (No.TTRO/1900) Order 2024" and shall come into force at 06.00 hours on the 19 February 2024 and ceases to have effect at 18.00 hours on the 28 June 2024 or until completion of the works, whichever is sooner.

Interpretation

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Temporary Speed Restriction

- (3) No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on each length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, during the period specified in Article 1, at a speed exceeding 30mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of prescribed traffic signs to Schedule 10, Part 2, Item 1 (Diagram 670) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

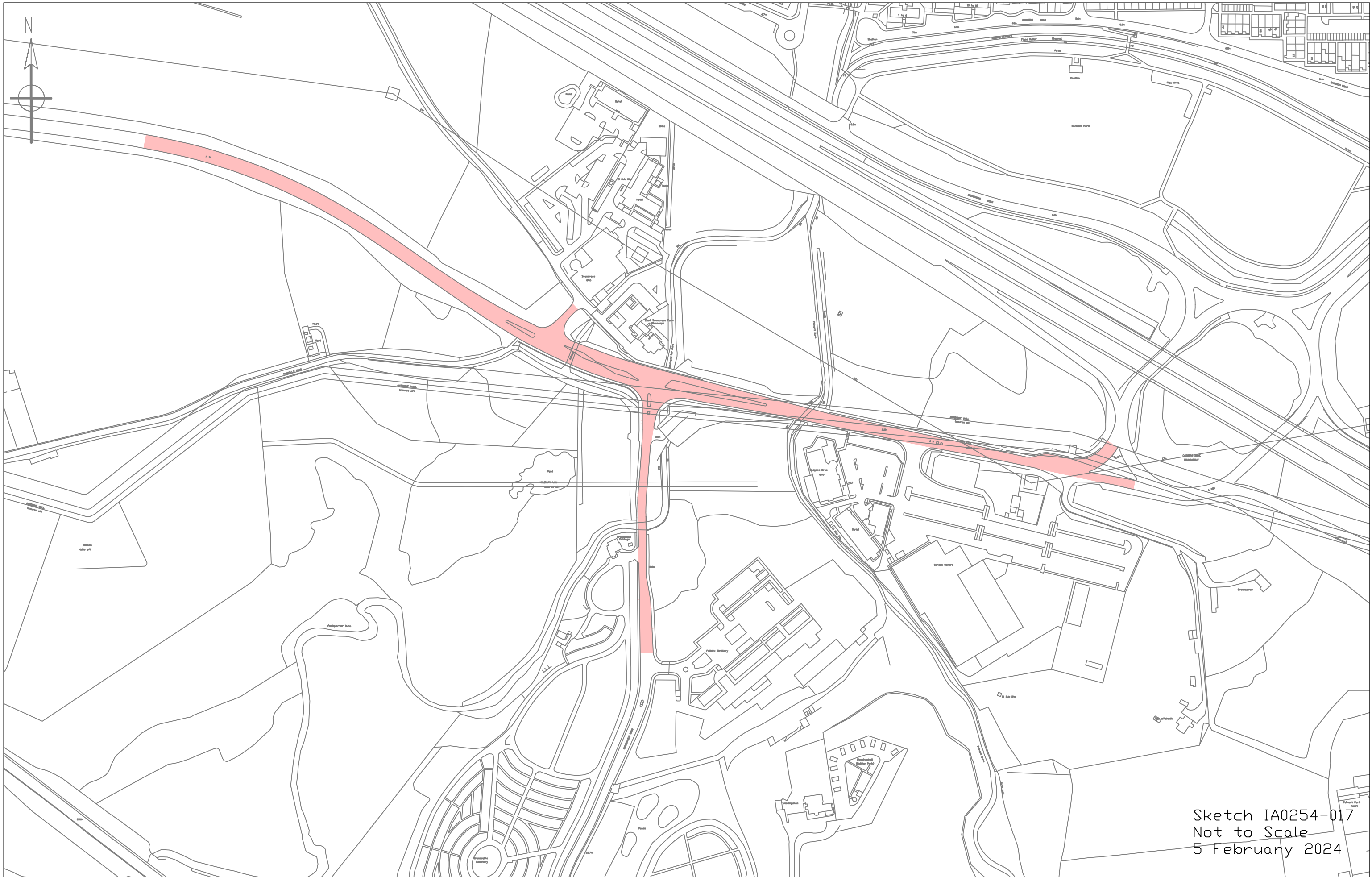
The effect of this Order shall be to temporarily restrict the speed of vehicles to 30mph on the lengths of road identified in the Schedule to this Order and shall come into force at 06.00 hours on the 19 February 2024 and ceases to have effect at 18.00 hours on the 28 June 2024 or until completion of the works, whichever is sooner.
