PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF ROAD HUMPS, MIDLOTHIAN Easter Langside Gardens, Dalkeith.

The Council proposes to install two road humps on Easter Langside Gardens, one 20m east and one 70m east of the roundabout junction with Cowden Road. This proposal is in response to concerns about speeds of vehicles and difficulty for pedestrians and cyclists crossing the road. The footpath/cyclepath which crosses here forms part of a safer route to school. The humps would be either side of the crossing point to slow down traffic on approach to and past this point

The humps would be sinsusoidal in profile, a maximum of 75mm high, 3.7m long and have tapered edges (i.e. small gaps between the hump and the kerbs or edge of carriageway at each side of the road) for drainage.
