

MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS ORDER 2018 ANNUAL BOYNE CELEBRATION PARADE - BONNYRIGG

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, which covers two parades will come into force at (a) Parade 1: 8.45am to 9.45am and (b) Parade 2: 3.45pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 30th June 2018. However once the participants of the event have passed through the restrictions, the roads will be re-opened. The restrictions are required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Annual Boyne Celebration Parade.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

The roads are being closed for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform. Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these temporary road closures.
