Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 11.30am on Thursday 4th October 2018 and is expected to remain in effect until 12.30pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the restrictions, the roads and junctions will be re-opened. - (f) B6372 West Street
- (g) Broomhill Road
- (h) Broomhill Avenue

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road restrictions will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
