

MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS ORDER 2019 PENICUIK HUNTER & LASS – RIDE OUT

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 7.30am on Saturday 25th May 2019 and is expected to remain in effect until 4pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the restrictions, the roads will be reopened. The restrictions are required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Penicuik Hunter & Lass Ride Out.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (a) A701 Edinburgh Road
- (b) B6372 West Street
- (c) A701 High Street
- (d) Jackson Street
- (e) Wilson Street
- (f) A701 John Street
- (g) Broomhill Road
- (h) Mauricewood Road
- (i) Eastfield Farm Road
- (j) Eastfield Industrial Estate Road
- (k) A701 St Kentigern Way

The roads are being closed for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

Alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
