

MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION ORDER - 2019 ROSLIN TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force between 4.00pm and 4.45pm on Saturday 21st December 2019 and have effect only as long as it takes the procession to pass through each junction and when the participants have passed through each one along the route, normal traffic movement will resume. The restriction is required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Roslin Torchlight Procession.

When the Order comes into effect the restriction will be enforced as the procession moves along the following roads:

- (a) Pentland View Terrace from Pavilion car park to Main Street
- (b) Main Street from Pentland View Terrace to Penicuik Road
- (c) Penicuik Road to Roslin Kirk

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road restrictions will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road restrictions.
