TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTIONS ORDER 2022
PENICUIK HUNTER & LASS – PENICUIK PRAM RACE

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 7.00pm on Wednesday 25th May 2022 and is expected to remain in effect until 8.30pm. However once the participants of the event have passed through the road restrictions, the roads will be re-opened. The closure is required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Penicuik Hunter & Lass Penicuik Pram Race.

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (a) **A701 Edinburgh Road**, junction of Queensway
- (b) **A701 John Street**
- (c) **A701 St Kentigern Way**
- (d) **A701 High Street**, to junction B6372 West Street
- (e) **B6372 West Street/Bog Road**, to junction of Wilson Street
- (f) **Wilson Street**, to junction of Jackson Street
- (g) **Jackson Street**

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
