

**THE MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL
(MAYFIELD, DALKEITH – VARIOUS ROADS)
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND ROAD RESTRICTIONS)
ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that Midlothian Council has made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is that for a temporary period to facilitate essential offsite drainage installation works in connection with a new housing development, there will be a rolling programme of road closures and waiting, loading and unloading restrictions as detailed in the below Schedules. The Order which has a maximum duration of 18 months has effect from 9 May 2022. The works are expected to take about 3 months to complete. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Alternative routes for general vehicular traffic will be clearly sign posted.

SCHEDULE 1: Rolling programme of temporary road closures as works progress:

- 1. Elm Place will be closed to through traffic from its junction with Bogwood Road to its junction with Mayfield Place from 6 June 2022 for 3 weeks**
- 2. Link Road/Footpath between Buckie Road and Bogwood Road will be closed from 11 July 2022 for up to 4 weeks**
- 3. David Scott Avenue will be closed to through traffic from its junction with Buckie Road to its junction with Rowantree Road from 8 August 2022 for up to 6 weeks**

SCHEDULE 2: Temporary No Waiting, Loading and Unloading Restrictions

- 1. Eskview Road– Northside layby immediately outside Mayfield Public Park**
