TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION ORDER - 2022
ROSLIN FUN DAY

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force between 12.00pm – 12.45pm on Saturday 10th September 2022 and have effect only as long as it takes the procession to pass through each junction and when the participants have passed through each one along the route, normal traffic movement will resume. The restriction is required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Roslin Fun Day parade.

When the Order comes into effect the restriction will be enforced as the procession moves along the following roads;

- (a) **Penicuik Road** starting at War memorial to B7006 Main Street
- (b) **B7006 Main Street, Roslin** from junction Penicuik Road to Pentland View Terrace
- (c) **Pentland View Terrace** from junction B7006 Main Street to Pentland View Crescent
- (d) **Pentland View Crescent** from Pentland View Terrace to Roslin Park

The roads are being restricted for road safety reasons.

The road restrictions will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road restrictions.
