

(TEMPORARY ROLLING ROAD CLOSURES) ORDER 2022

GOREBRIDGE LOYAL ORANGE LODGE NO. 25 - PARADE 10 SEPTEMBER 2022

Midlothian Council have made the above Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order, will come into force at 18:30 hrs on Saturday 10 September 2022 and is expected to remain in effect until 19:30 hrs. However once the participants of the event have passed through the road closures, the roads will be re-opened. The closures are required to facilitate the holding of a relevant event, being the Gorebridge Loyal Orange Lodge No. 25 Parade

When the Order comes into effect no person shall drive, or cause, or permit to be driven any vehicle along:

- (a) **Hunter Square** from Bowling Club to Hunterfield Road
- (b) **Hunterfield Road** from Hunter Square to Gore Avenue
- (c) **Gore Avenue** from Hunterfield Road to Burnside Road
- (d) **Burnside Road** from Gore Avenue to Hillside Crescent North
- (e) **Hillside Crescent North** from Burnside Road to Arnprior Road
- (f) **Arnprior Road** from Hillside Crescent North to Vogrie Crescent South
- (g) **Vogrie Crescent South** from Arnprior Road to Lower Bonnybank Road
- (h) **Lower Bonnybank Road** from Vogrie Crescent South to Hunter Square
- (i) **Hunter Square** from Lower Bonnybank Road to Bowling Club

The roads are being closed for road safety reasons.

The road closures will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform.

During the event, local access will be retained for residents along the affected routes.

Emergency vehicles attending an emergency call are exempt from this order.

No alternative route signing will be provided during these road closures.
