THE MIDLOTHIAN COUNCIL (STRAITON PARK) STOPPING UP ORDER 2022 - TO/R5.3.17

The Midlothian Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 68(1)(b) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and having considered that the road specified in the Schedule to this Order has become unnecessary and being satisfied that alternative roads exist, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as "The Midlothian Council (Straiton Park) Stopping Up Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of November Two thousand and twenty two.
- 2. The stopping up of the length of road in the Midlothian local government area specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
- 3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said length of road is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across the length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

SCHEDULE

Length of Road to be Stopped Up

Un-named cul-de-sac road running south-westwards from B702 Loanhead Road, Straiton, Midlothian from a point 33 metres or thereby south-east of the extended outer kerbline of the roundabout junction between the A701 and B702 roads, including the footways alongside the road and across the head of the cul-de-sac, a distance of 110 metres or thereby.
